City Tours





in Kibale National Park, zebras in Lake Mburo National Park and a mighty waterfall on river Nile in Murchison Falls National Park.

Upon arrival, the following day we travel to Murchison Falls N. P. Here we spend the next two night. We spend our day time exploring wildlife of R. Nile that include Nile crocodiles, hippos, and a lot of water birds. For giraffes, lions, leopards, Uganda kobs, heartebeast, oribis to mention but a few, we go on a game drive.

Part of this itinerary takes us to Fortportal town on way to Kibale N.P for primate tracking. Chips on top of the list but also Red tailed Monkeys, Olive Baboons, Red Colobus Monkeys.

We get to Queen Elizabeth N.P. on day 6 for game drive

and boat trip on Kazinga channel. We go through Ishasha on our way to Bwindi on day 8.

Day 10 transfer to Lake Mburo National Park, overnight in the park.

Day 11 transfer to Jinja for the source of the Nile. We spend a night in Jinja. We conclude on the 12th day and transfer to the airport for you flight.

Along this tour expect to see the Shoebill stork, the Carmine bee Eaters, Abyssinian ground Hornbills, Red-headed Weaver, Yellow billed Shrike, Vaneceous Dove, Great Blue Eared Starling, Rock Prantincoles, Bat Hawk, Spotted Greenbul, Blue-throated Roller, Chestnut capped Flycatcher, Ituri Batis. Again this can be modified according to your wishlist.


