



## **CHITTAGONG HILL TRACTS & COX'S BAZAR TOUR**

Arrival at Dhaka International Airport. Meet & greet at the airport and transfer by representative and guide to pre- confirmed hotel of your choice. Overnight at the hotel in Dhaka.

Dhaka is more than 1500 years old city, and became capital of the country in 1608 under the Mughal rule. During ancient and medieval periods the city was known to the world for its unique product, the Muslin – the finest fabric ever produced in the world. As the capital of Bangladesh it has grown into a bustling city of trades and commerce, cultural and sport activities, vibrating with full of life. The city has two parts – the old part and the new part. The old part is known as the Old Dhaka, which developed during the Mughal period. With the happy blending of the old and new architectural trends, traditions and modernization, Dhaka has been expanding so fast since the independence of Bangladesh in 1971. At present about 15 million people live in the city. Now the city of Dhaka is filled with history, tradition and culture. It has endless numbers of activities, attractions accommodations and business opportunities.

## DAY-1 ARRIVAL AT **DHAKA**

# DAY-2 AT **DHAKA**

#### 30-JUL-2022, SATURDAY





After buffet breakfast at the hotel proceed to full day sightseeing covering **National Parliament** Building- (outside view only) The great mass of concrete lined with strips of marble, marked by the outer wall openings and the predominance of geometric forms of circular and rectangular concrete offer a great tribute to the building, fairly consistent with the noble functions that take place in the interior.

•Lalbagh fort (closed on Sunday) - It is an old Mughal fort in the southwestern part Dhaka City.

•Dhakeswari Temple - is a famous Hindu temple in Dhaka first built in 12th century, and later rebuilt and renovated numerous times.

•National Museum - the museum, located at Shahbag, started its journey in 1913. Overnight at the hotel in Dhaka.



Buffet Breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Sonargaon to visit Panam Nagar at Sonargaon (About 29 km from Dhaka).

Sonargaon Folk Art Museum & Goaldi Mosque (The Goaldi Mosque is one of the very few surviving medieval monuments in the city of Sonargaon about half mile northwest of the little township of Panam. Built in 1519, the graceful, single-domed Goaldi Mosque is the most impressive of the few extant monuments of the old capital city, and a good example of pre-Mu-ghal architecture).

Later proceed to Chittagong via Comilla to visit old Buddhist Ruins in Mainamati, Comilla.

After arrival at Chittagong transfer to hotel. Dinner at local restaurant & overnight at Hotel in Chittagong.

## DAY-3 AT **DHAKA-CHITTAGONG**

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner 244 KM APPROX.



## DAY-4 AT **CHITTAGONG-RANGAMATI**

#### Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner 77 KM APPROX.

After breakfast at hotel proceed to Rangamati. En-route visit **Shrine of Bayazid Bostami** (was a famous Persian Sufi born in Bostam, Iran. Its shrine area as a complex consists of a tomb surrounded by a brick structure along with an old mosque and a large pond).

After arrival at Rangamati excursion by Motor Boat on the **Kaptai Lake** with its splendid setting of lush landscape and scenic grandeur and visit tribal village. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Rangamati.





### DAY-5 AT **RANGAMATI-BANDARBAN**

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner 79 KM APPROX.

After breakfast visit Rajban Vihara, Buddhist temple.

After sightseeing drive to the hill district Bandarban. Afternoon visit the **Golden temple** The Buddha Dhatu Jadi also known as the Bandarban Golden Temple is located close to Balaghata town, in Bandarban City, in Bangladesh. **Local bazaar** at Bandarban. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Bandarban.



### DAY-7 AT **COX'S BAZAR – DHAKA**

FLY FROM COX'S BAZAR Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Breakfast at Hotel. Half day excursion to Himchari and Inani Beach. Afternoon free on the beach. Late afternoon proceed to Cox's Bazar airport for heading towards Dhaka. Dinner at local restaurant and overnight at Hotel in Dhaka.

### DAY-6 AT **BANDARBAN-COX'S BAZAR**

#### Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner 115 KM APPROX.

Breakfast at Hotel. Morning visit different types **Tribal Villages** to see their lifestyle by **Chander gari**.

Later back to Bandarban and proceed to Cox's Bazar. En-route visit **Buddhist Temples/Pagoda** in Ramu. Late afternoon arrival cox's bazaar and transfer to Hotel. Enjoy the sunset on the Beach if time permits. Dinner & Overnight at Hotel in Cox's Bazar.





### DAY-8 AT **DEPARTURE**

#### Meal: Breakfast

Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out from the hotel and drive towards Dhaka airport for move ahead to the next destination.

Please Note: Rangamati, Khagrachhari, and Bandarban are three hill tracts districts maintained by the district administration, BGB, and Bangladesh military. Foreigners need permission for visiting these districts from the Home Ministry of Bangladesh and the application must be submitted a month ahead of the scheduled visit along with a passport copy, visa number, departure and arrival time, the district he intends to visit, the purpose of visit, activities detail, duration of stay, mode of travel, expected date of return, etc.
