

ENCHANTING BANGLADESH (DHAKA, COX'S BAZAR) 04 Nights 05 Days Tour

Cox's Bazar (120 kilometers) World Longest Natural Sea Beach is one of them. It is the tourist capital of Bangladesh. Miles of golden sands, towering cliffs, surfing waves, rare conch shells, colorful pagodas, Buddhist temples and tribes, delightful sea-food--this is Cox's Bazar.

Day-1: Arrival

Arrival at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport. Meet & greet at the Terminal-2 and transfer by our representative and guide to your pre-confirmed hotel of your choice. Your Bangladeshi adventure will begin with an orientation of the guide. Enjoy the Bangladesh tour with the blessings from **Dhakeswari Temple**. Dhakeswari, meaning 'Goddess of Dhaka' is the primary Hindu temple in Bangladesh. According to legend Dhakeshwari was built in the 12th century by King Ballal Sen of the Sena dynasty. It is said the king dreamt of a statue of the goddess Durga buried in the jungle and



after finding the statue installed it in his temple as Dhakeshwari. Later visit the Lord Curzon Hall - the building was originally intended to be a town hall and is named after Lord Curzon, the Viceroy of



India who laid its foundation stone in 1904. Dinner at local restaurant & overnight at Hotel in Dhaka.

Dhaka is more than 1500 years old city, and became capital of the country in 1608 under the Mughal rule. During ancient and medieval periods the city was known to the world for its unique product, the Muslin - the finest fabric ever produced in the world. As the capital of Bangladesh it has grown into a bustling city of trades and commerce, cultural and sport activities, vibrating with full of life. The city has two parts - the old part and the new part. The old part is known as the Old Dhaka, which developed during the Mughal period. With the happy blending of the old and new architectural trends, traditions and modernization, Dhaka has been expanding so fast since the independence of Bangladesh in 1971. At present about 15 million people live in the city. Now the city of Dhaka is filled with history, tradition and culture. It has endless numbers of activities, attractions accommodations and business opportunities.

Day-02: Dhaka - Cox's Bazar [Morning flight from Dhaka]

After breakfast at hotel proceed to Dhaka airport for heading towards Cox's Bazar. Arrival at Cox's Bazar and meet with the driver. Today we will visit **Himchari Beach** - It consists of lush tropical rain



forest, grasslands and trees. Himchari is also famous for its hilltop view of the sea and features a number of waterfalls, the biggest of which cascades down toward the sandy, sun-drenched beach is a rare scene to enjoy. Ramu Buddhist Village - It is a typical Buddhist village located 16 kilometres



away from Cox's Bazar. Evening free for beach walk. Overnight at the hotel in Cox's Bazar.

Day-03: Cox's Bazar

Breakfast at hotel and full day free excursion at beach and shopping at Cox's Bazar. Lunch at local restaurant and dinner at hotel. Overngiht at the hotel in Cox's Bazar.



Day-04: Cox's Bazar - Dhaka [Morning flight from Cox's Bazar]

After breakfast at hotel check-out and proceed to Dhaka by flight. Arrive at Dhaka airport and visit Bardi Baba Loknath Ashram - a saint and Hindu religion's spiritual philosopher in Bengal. The place



is also very near to Joyti Basu's paternal house. It is holy place for Bengali Hindu pilgrimages. Main festivals day is celebrated in June every year of Tirodhan Dibos (on Tithi) of Baba. Overngiht at the hotel in Dhaka.

[Note: This year the Tirodhan Utsav will be held on 2nd June 2023]

Afetr that in the evening go for a River cruising at Shitalakshya River. Welcome to cruising with local



snacks and tea/coffee. Enjoy 1-2 hours cruising at the river. Later dissembark from the boat and proceed to hotel. Overnight at the hotel in Dhaka.

Day -05, 18th Jun 2023 (Sunday): Departure

Breakfast at the hotel and take the blessings from Ramna Kali Temple - is a temple in Dhaka that



was originally built in the time of the Mughal Empire. It was also known as the "Ramna Kalibari". The temple is dedicated to the Hindu Goddess Kali. Then move ahead to airport for fly back to your next destination. Within this the tour will be end with happy memories.
