# Story

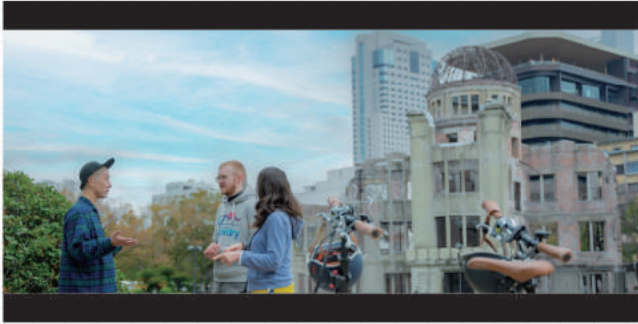
Hiroshima City, world-renowned as a city of peace. However, the city hasn't always been this way from its inception.

We embark from the Peace Park to visit local spots in the outskirts where stories passed down through generations await. You can feel the preciousness of peaceful daily life and the resilience of the people will convey an important message to all of us living in the present.

On that day, within a radius of approximately 2.5 kilometers from the Peace Park, the entire area was turned into a scorched wasteland by a single atomic bomb. Enduring the immense power of that event, Hiroshima city still hosts scattered remnants that have remained unchanged since that fateful moment. Each of these sites holds stories that must be told. During the tour, we share hidden stories about everyday things such as "How the Peace Park came into being" and "The sentiments embedded in the streetcars."

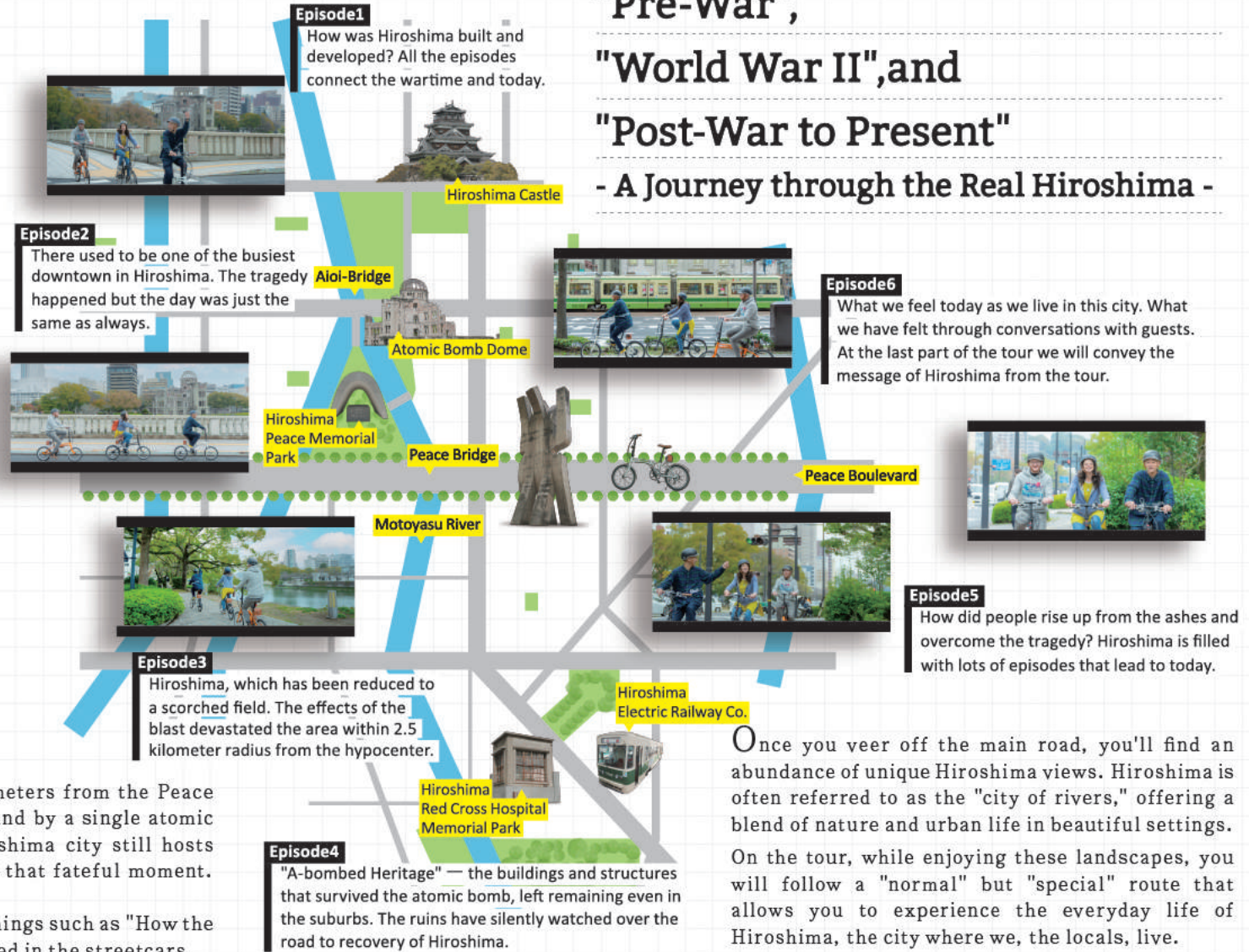
