First lit in 1918, it has been protecting the safety of the sea for more than 100 years. Distance to Kyushu is only about 14Km(8.7mile). It takes about 20 minutes to reach the lighthouse on foot.

The Overview

Welcome to the westernmost tip of Shikoku, Sadamisaki Peninsula! We, Sadamisaki Tourism Organization(DMO) bring you short hikes with spectacular views and a spot of fresh local seafood like no other ! If you're looking for a nature-eco tour and immersive travel experience, you're in the right place.

Travel highlights

- ▷ A light walk takes you to **Sadamisaki Lighthouse**, the westernmost point of Shikoku.
On the opposite shore, Kyushu can be seen up close.
- ▷ A walk through the village and a visit to the **Sadamisaki Peninsula Museum** offers a glimpse into the culture and customs nurtured in the harsh environment of the peninsula.
- ▷ You can enjoy **fresh seafood** just landed at the nearby fishing port!
- ▷ Relieve your fatigue in a **new hot spring spa**, fully equipped with an open-air bath, just opened in 2024!
- ▷ **Fishing boat cruises** and **e-bike** rentals available if you like.

Recommended itinerary (For one-day trip)

Your journey starts at **JR Yawatahama Station**, 50-minutes express train ride from JR Matsuyama Station. The area(Ikata & Yawatahama) is rich in marine resources and is the gateway to Kyushu. Upon arrival at the station, a private cab will pick you up and take you to the Misaki port (about 50-min drive). You will head for **Sadamisaki Lighthouse**, the westernmost point of Shikoku (about 20-min walk). After enjoying lunch, you can visit the **Sadamisaki Museum** to learn about the peninsula's unique culture and history. After getting to know the culture, you will **stroll to small villages** with spectacular views of the blue sea (Approx. 1 hour, 4 km). At the trail's finish line is **Kamegaike Onsen (Hot Springs)**, which offers relaxation and rest for the slightly tired body. After the hot springs, we will take you to JR Yawatahama Station and return to Matsuyama by express train. For those who want to stay more, you can stay overnight at Kamegaike Onsen or in Yawatahama City, which has many restaurants offering fresh seafood.

Access to Sadamisaki Peninsula

- ★ From Matsuyama: ① Iyotetsu Express Bus ② JR Train (nearest station : Yawatahama St.)
- ★ From Kyushu (Oita): Ferry (①Saganoseki ⇄ Misaki port 70min / ②Beppu or Usuki ⇄ Yawatahama port)
- ★ From Yawatahama (station/port) : ①Iyotetsu Local bus, ②Rental car, ③Taxi, ④Bike or E-bike
- ★ RV(Recreational vehicle)/Caravan, Motorcycles can also be rented in Matsuyama City.

You can drive along the winding roads of the beautiful coastline.

Attractions

- Sadamisaki Trail (Section 1 to 5)
Trails can be enjoyed to the westernmost tip of Shikoku
- Sakiori waving experience(ancient Japanese loom)
- Masonry culture has built houses and fields by piling stones on steep slopes.
- Lots of ways to enjoy the outdoors attractions, such as cycling, camping and BBQ.
