DAY 02 NEGOMBO / DAMBULLA / MINNERIYA / DAMBULLA

- After breakfast leave for Dambulla.
- En route visit Dambulla Cave Temple.

Dambulla Cave Temple

Dambulla rock temple dating back to the 1st Century BC. Which served as the refuge to King Valagambahu of Anuradhapura in 1st Century BC. The five grotto shrines contain numerous images of Buddha and guardian deities. The frescoes on the walls and ceilings date back to the Kandyan period. view from top of the rock is breath-taking.

- Afternoon Safari by Jeep at Minneriya National Park.

Minneriya National Park

Minneriya National Park affords the opportunity to sight herds of Elephants throughout the year. During the year up to 300 elephants are seen at the 8,890-hectare park within a few square kilometres of the Minneriya Reservoir. In August and September each year during the dry season, wild elephants from the surrounding wilderness in search of food and water, makes their way to the shores of the Minneriya Reservoir adjoining the Minneriya National Park.

- After breakfast visit Sigiriya Rock Fortress.

Sigiriya Rock Fortress

Sigiriya is one of the most valuable historical monuments of Sri Lanka. Referred by locals as the Eighth Wonder of the World this ancient palace and fortress complex has significant archaeological importance and attracts thousands of tourists every year. Sigiriya rock, the ‘Rock Fortress in the sky’ built in the 5th century AD by the parricide king Kasyappa. The archaeological findings bear testimony to a well-developed urban planning, architecture, gardening, engineering, hydraulic technology and art. ‘The celestial ladies’ of Sigiriya, the mirror walls and the lion’s stair way bear testimony to the splendor of a bygone era. Sigiriya has been declared a world heritage by UNESCO.



- Proceed to Kandy.
- En route visit Spice Garden Matale.

Spice garden

Visit the spice gardens in Matale where you could get an insight to the different spices for which Sri Lanka was well known. Enjoy 15 Min. Complementary Spa & Massage Treatment from spice garden.



- Evening view a cultural dance show and visit Sri Daladha Maligawa. (The Temple of Sacred Tooth Relic of Lord Buddha)

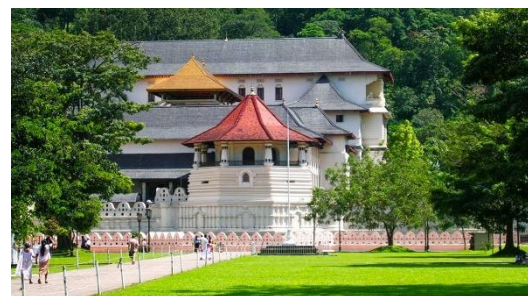
The Kandy Cultural Dance show

The Kandy Cultural Dance show is a stimulating Sri Lankan art, dance & cultural heritage show that is must see for any visitor who visits the historic city of Kandy. It has become a tourist attraction for many people visiting the country and keen on a glimpse of its rich cultural heritage.



Temple of the Tooth

Kandy is a major city in Sri Lanka, located in the Central Province, Sri Lanka. Kandy is the home of The Temple of the Tooth Relic (Sri Dalada Maligawa), one of the most sacred places of worship in the Buddhist world. It was declared a world heritage site by UNESCO in 1988. The Temple of the Tooth, where the Lord Buddha's tooth is enshrined and worshipped, occupies a place of pride and devotion.

City Tour of Kandy

In the afternoon city tour of Kandy. Kandy is the center of Sinhalese culture and Buddhism in Sri Lanka. The lake of Kandy adds charm and serenity to the ancient royal city. From the Upper Lake drive the visitor could enjoy a bird's view of the city of Kandy. Thereafter visit the Temple of the Tooth, where the sacred Tooth Relic of Buddha is enshrined and venerated. The Dalada maligawa, the Temple of the sacred tooth relic occupies a place of pride and devotion.



- Visit Peradeniya and visit Royal Botanical Garden, Peradeniya.

Peradeniya Botanical Garden

Visit the Royal Botanical Gardens at Peradeniya. Initiated in 1816 by the British, today it is famous for its collection of plants from all over the world, the avenue of the spices and of the Royal Palm Trees and still more for its fabulous collection of orchids.

- Proceed to Colombo.
- En route visit Pinnawala & visit Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage.

Pinnawala

House the abandoned and the wounded, the orphanage has grown to be a big family today. A unique experience never to be missed. Pinnawala Initiated in 1975 by the state zoological department with a few orphaned baby elephants today has developed into a major tourist attraction. The baby elephants are bottle-fed with milk and the hard numbering over 60 are driven to the nearby river Maha Oya for a refreshing river bath. It is a delight to watch them bathing in the water.

Gangarama Temple

Gangaramaya is one of the oldest Buddhist temples in Colombo, Sri Lanka. It is not only one of the Buddhist temples but also one of the most iconic beautiful temples in Sri Lanka.
