Meandering along scenic rivers, quaint villages, and wooded mountain passes, this quiet road is today nearly bereft of cars, making it ideal for cyclists.

We’ll stop along the way to meet local people, sample the delicious country fare, stay in a traditional family-owned inn, and learn about the unique culture that has evolved here over the centuries.

Your journey continues over a secluded ridge-road with panoramic views of Wakasa Bay, around the circumference of a scenic lake, and along breathtaking coastline.
