

The **Republic of San Marino** enchants the eyes of visitors with its characteristic beauty and proud uniqueness. In summer you can attend the solemn Changing of the Guard. which takes place at the Public Palace, and breathe the charm of a timeless place by visiting the beautiful Cava dei Balestrieri and admiring the evocative historical re-enactments with a medieval theme.

Only in the **Old Town** of San Marino, granted the title of World Heritage Site by **UNESCO** together with that of **Borgo Maggiore** and **Mount Titano**, **you have the opportunity to go shopping along the streets**, in an authentic open-air shopping mall, and buy characteristic **products: artistic handicrafts**, **highly sought-after stamps**, **precious coins** of the Republic (at the Philatelic and Numismatic Office) and traditional **ceramic creations**. Furthermore, the Old Town offers hundreds of shops and restaurants where you can buy **your souvenirs and taste the local food and wine delicacies**.

And if you love to follow fashion trends, **San Marino Outlet Experience** awaits you with a selection of boutiques of international standing.
