

# Introducing 'Le Space Inspire'

L'ESPACE is the largest immersive media art exhibition in Korea (approx. 60,000m<sup>2</sup>), where various media arts such as large-scale media walls, interactive content, kinetic sculptures, holograms, and much more are connected into one story.

"LE Space" is a term that combines Lumiere (light), Experience, and Space, meaning 'a space that offers a perfect immersive experience with fantastic light and sensory sound.'

## Prologue

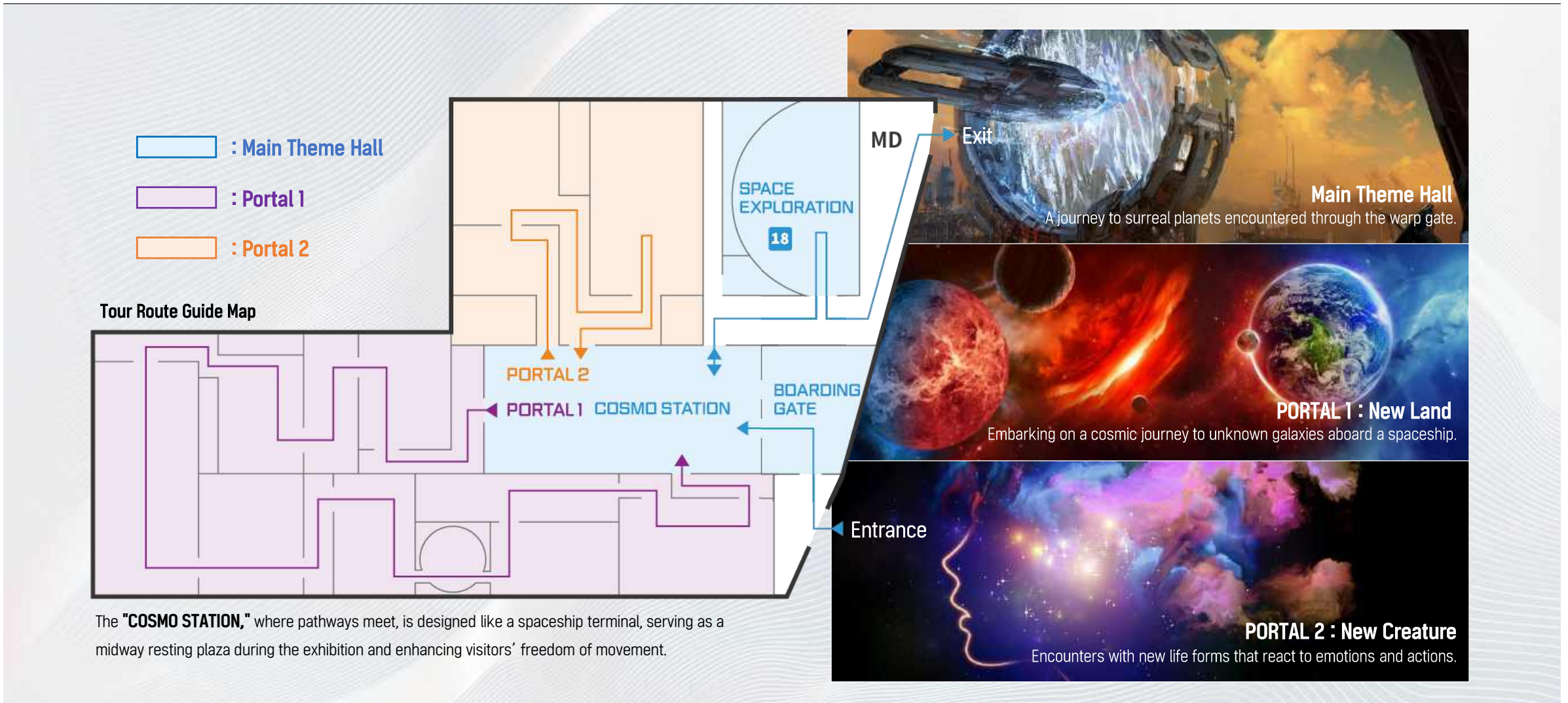
An island that connects the earth and the sky, Yeongjongdo.  
A warp gate that transcends time and space has been discovered in the skies of Yeongjongdo. A galaxy travel package starting from the Cosmos Station, accessed through the warp gate, has emerged. Through portals that transcend time and space, you can experience a new dimension of the universe, a new planet resembling Earth, and encounters with new life forms.

This exhibition plan reflects the geographical feature of being an island (Yeongjongdo) located 10 minutes from the international Incheon airport. Using the airport as a metaphor, we created a scenario with the theme of space journey beginning through a warp gate.



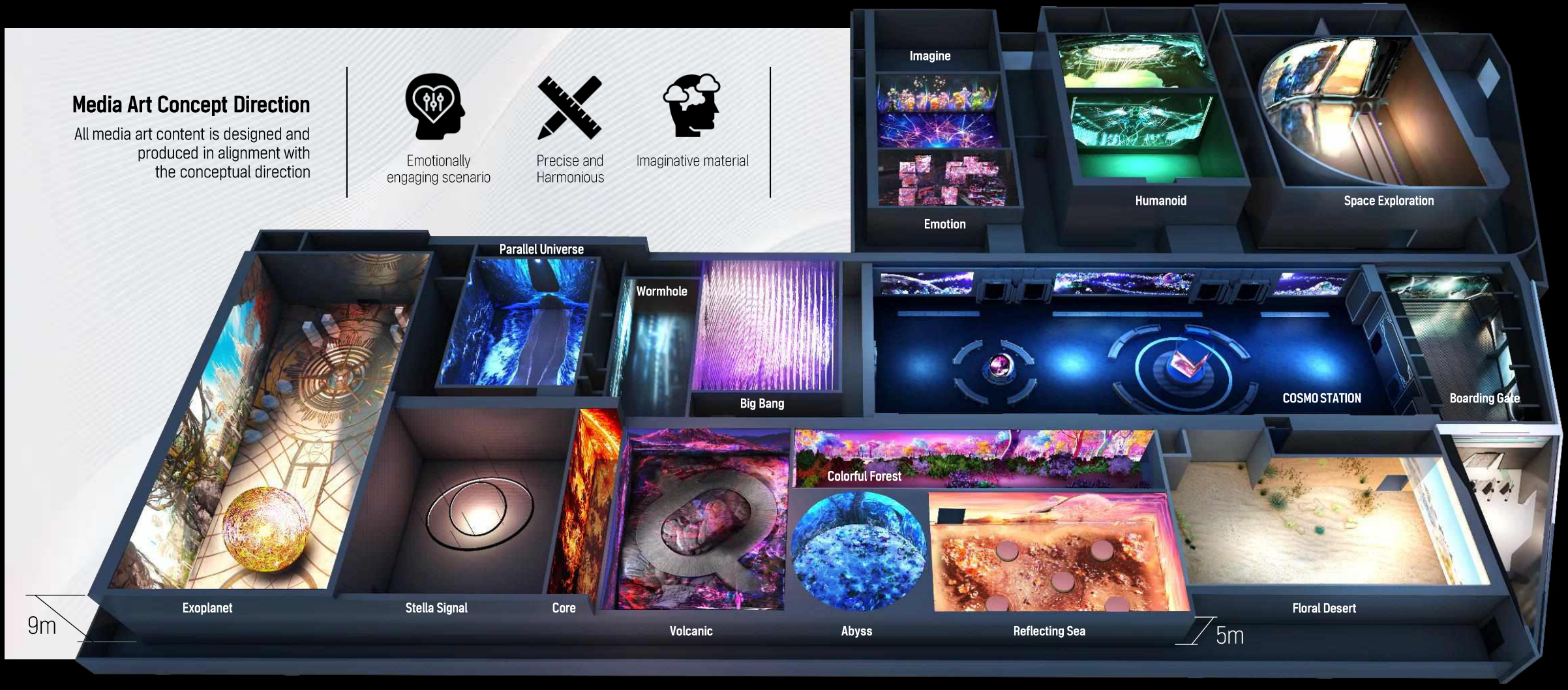
# Exhibition Zone Planning

The zoning is divided into three main themes, each allowing visitors to freely navigate without following a specific order. The "Main Theme Hall," positioned at the beginning and end, serves as a thematic space depicting the process of boarding and disembarking from a spaceship, enhancing visitors' understanding of the exhibition's universe.



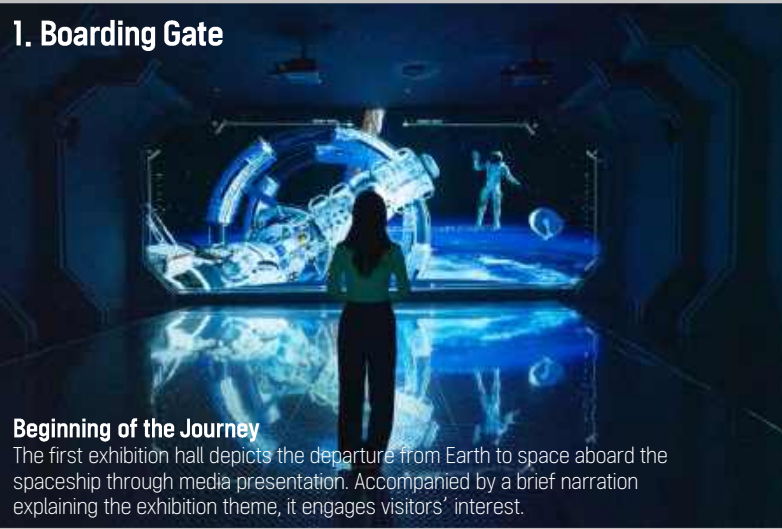
# Composition of the Exhibition

The exhibition consists of 17 halls, each featuring different media, interiors, and content to provide a diverse range of experiences. The space heights are divided into two categories: 5 meters and 9 meters. The 9-meter height emphasizes a grand scale, while the 5-meter height focuses on various sculptural attractions, applying designs suited to each scale.



# Details of the Exhibition **\_Main Theme Hall**

## 1. Boarding Gate



### Beginning of the Journey

The first exhibition hall depicts the departure from Earth to space aboard the spaceship through media presentation. Accompanied by a brief narration explaining the exhibition theme, it engages visitors' interest.

## 2. COSMO STATION



### The Central Hub of the New Galactic Journey, COSMO STATION

It serves as the central hub of the new galactic journey, connecting portals to other spacetime dimensions. The interior design and visual projections create an atmosphere reminiscent of stepping into a spaceship.

## 3. Space Exploration



### Space Exploration

A half-cylinder theater hall screening a narrative of spaceship travel to explore beautiful planets. A 9-meter high curved surround wall is used as a projector screen to create an immersive media art experience that surpasses cinematic experiences.

## 4. Big Bang



### The Beginning of Everything, The Big Bang

A room filled with line dot LEDs to create the Milky Way. The light waves of stars ripple and then suddenly explode, representing the birth of the universe.

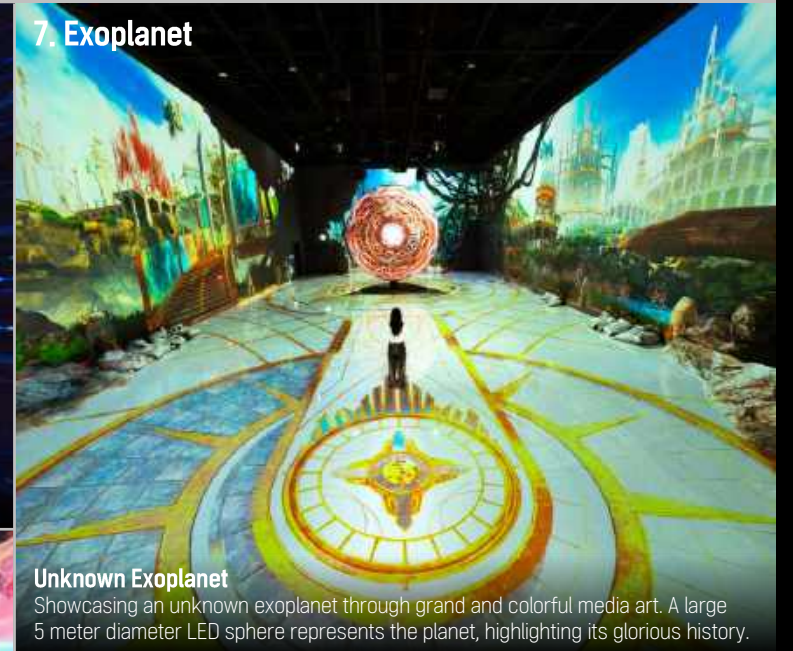
## 5. Wormhole



### Wormhole Warping Space-Time

A passage using line LEDs to depict a 'wormhole' pulling you into a new dimension the walls are made of reflective black glass to create an illusion of space expanding like a kaleidoscope.

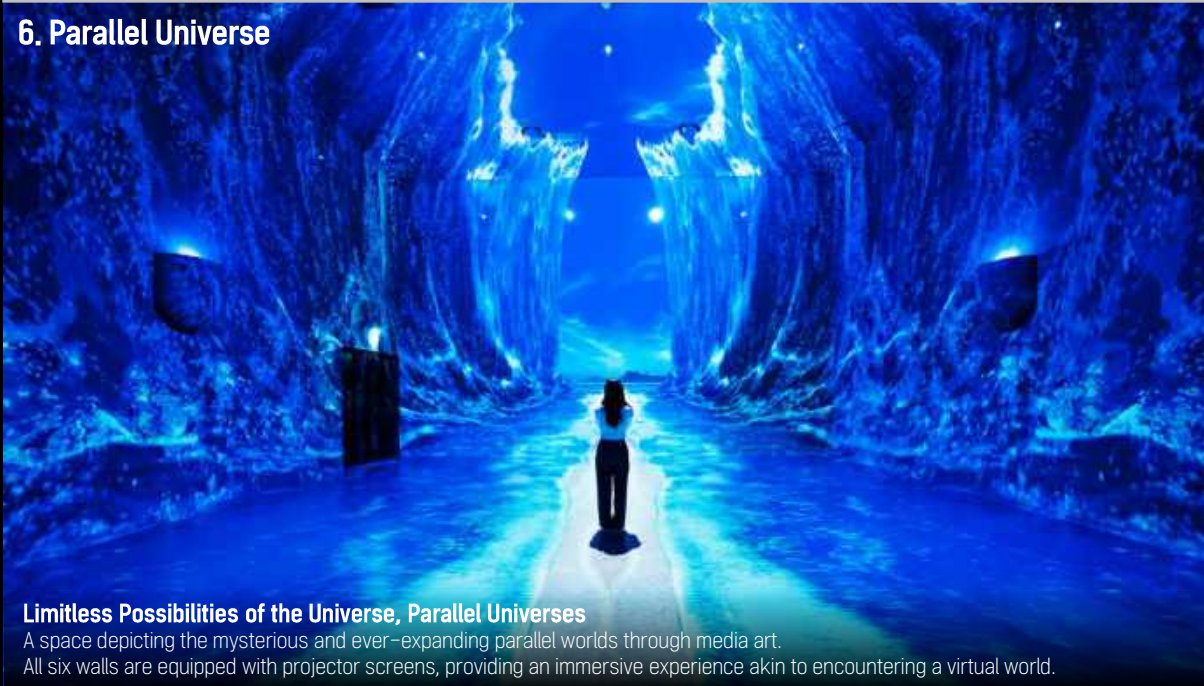
## 7. Exoplanet



### Unknown Exoplanet

Showcasing an unknown exoplanet through grand and colorful media art. A large 5 meter diameter LED sphere represents the planet, highlighting its glorious history.

## 6. Parallel Universe



### Limitless Possibilities of the Universe, Parallel Universes

A space depicting the mysterious and ever-expanding parallel worlds through media art. All six walls are equipped with projector screens, providing an immersive experience akin to encountering a virtual world.

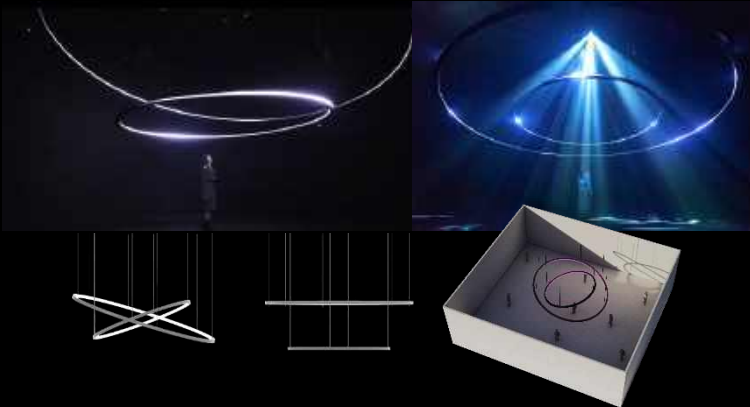

## 8. Stella Signal



### Lighthouse of the Universe, Stellar Signal

The space is visually distinguished by two large kinetic rings as the centerpiece. Rhythmically moving lights create a mysterious effect, as if guiding visitors to a new planet.

## 9. Core



### Core of a New World

Another passage guiding you to the center of a new planet. Lively media and wall sculptures depict the boiling lava and flames of the core.

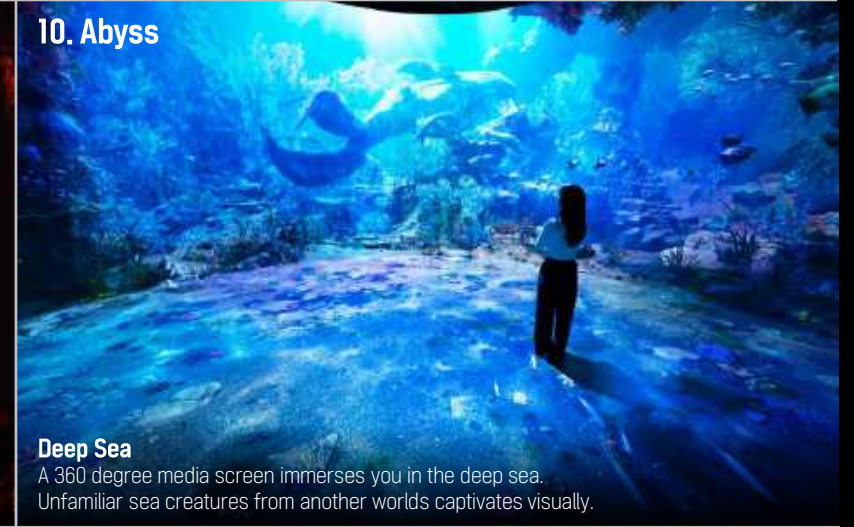
## 11. Volcanic



### Dynamic Volcanic Area

The area featuring a mysterious volcanic landscape and ecosystem through media art. Realistic volcanic terrain is created with detailed sculptures and fog effects.

## 10. Abyss



### Deep Sea

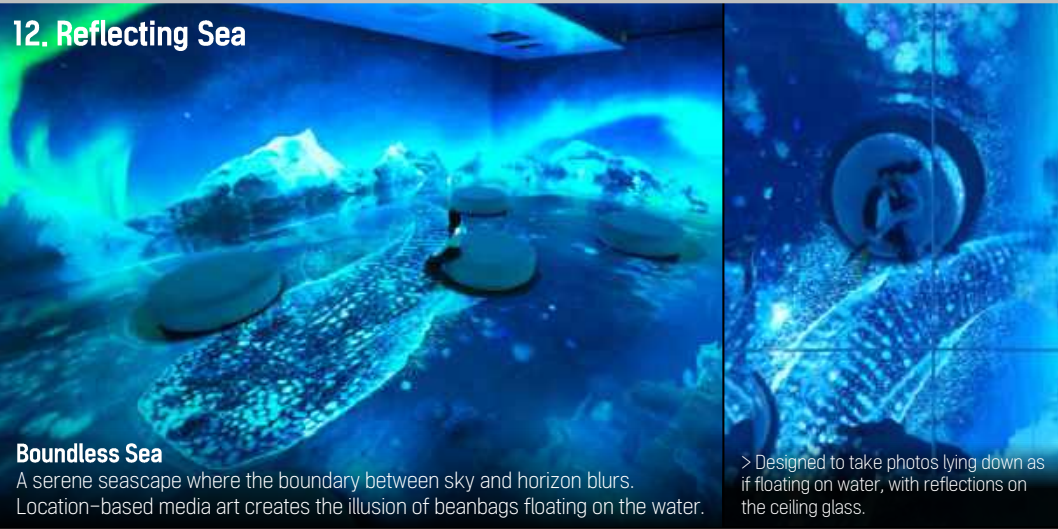
A 360 degree media screen immerses you in the deep sea. Unfamiliar sea creatures from another worlds captivates visually.

## 12. Reflecting Sea

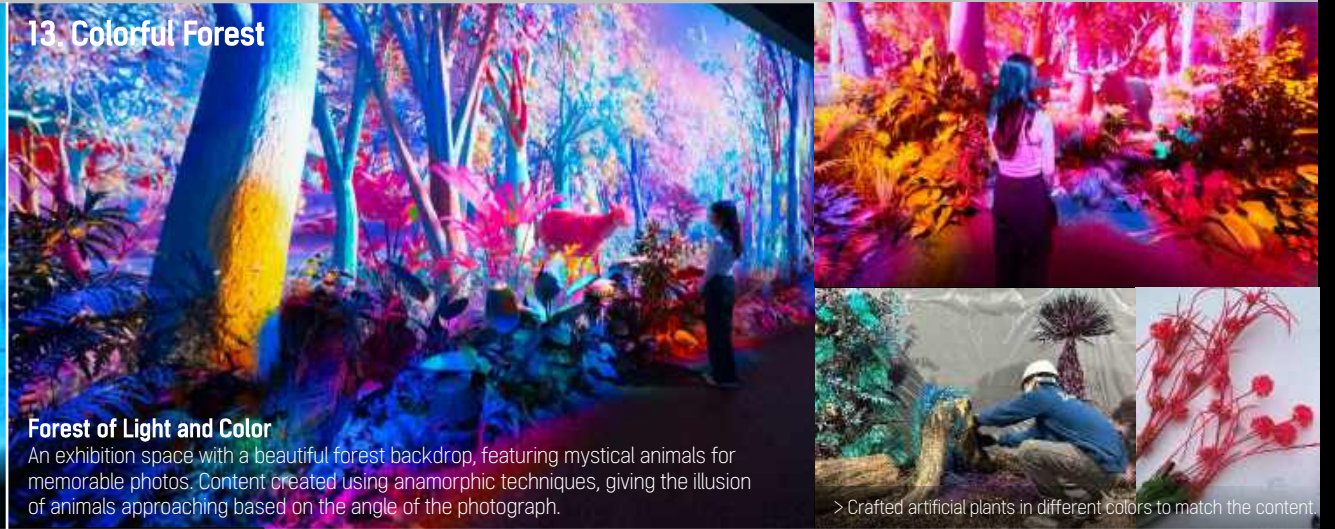


### Boundless Sea

A serene seascape where the boundary between sky and horizon blurs. Location-based media art creates the illusion of beanbags floating on the water.

> Designed to take photos lying down as if floating on water, with reflections on the ceiling glass.

## 13. Colorful Forest



### Forest of Light and Color

An exhibition space with a beautiful forest backdrop, featuring mystical animals for memorable photos. Content created using anamorphic techniques, giving the illusion of animals approaching based on the angle of the photograph.

## 14. Floral Desert



### Blooming Desert

A bright room showcasing a surreal desert full of life, resembling Earth. Real sand and rock sculptures add a touch of realism to the space.



> Surreal motion graphics of blooming and scattering flowers contrast with the desert interior.

> Sculptures with sand for realistic desert rock texture.

## 15. Emotion



### Blossoms of Emotion

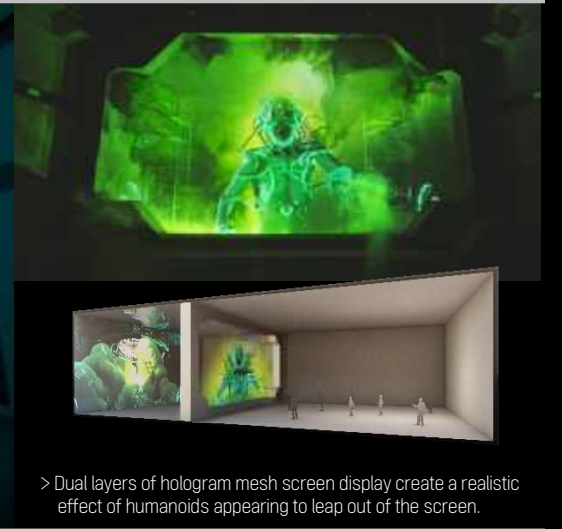
An exhibit featuring new creatures that react to human emotions. Expression detection sensors create fireworks-like color patterns based on the visitor's facial expressions.

## 16. Humanoid



### Humanoids of a New Planet

A performance of humanoids created with advanced technology surpassing Earth's. Integrated use of laser lights, fog, and hologram media to create stunning visuals.



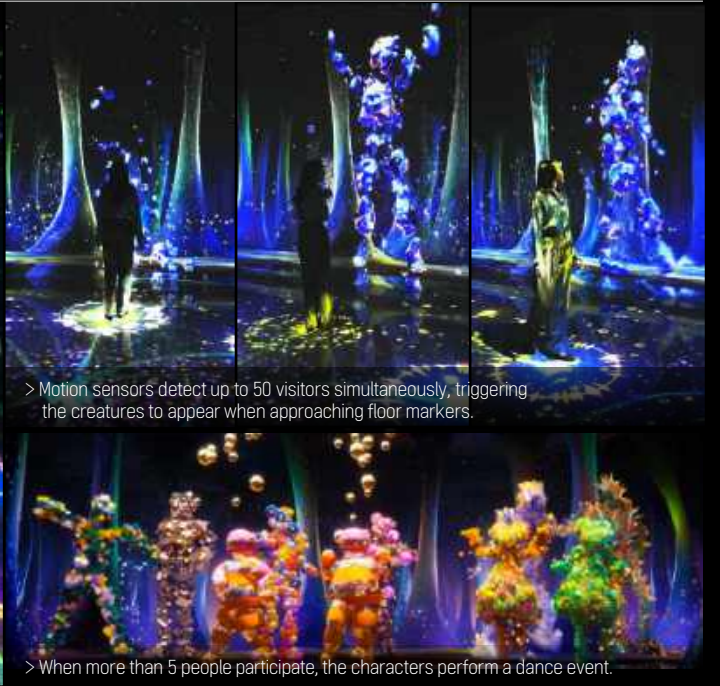
> Dual layers of hologram mesh screen display create a realistic effect of humanoids appearing to leap out of the screen.

## 17. Imagine



### Imaginary Creatures, Imagine

A space featuring colorful, fantastical characters through media art. Motion sensors create an interactive experience, making the imaginary creatures follow the visitors' movements.



> Motion sensors detect up to 50 visitors simultaneously, triggering the creatures to appear when approaching floor markers.

> When more than 5 people participate, the characters perform a dance event.
