Togakushi shrine (Nagano City)

Snow still remains on the approach to Togakushi Shrine Okusha, which opens in mid-April.It is a special time to walk surrounded by magnificent cedar trees.

Okususobana Nature Garden (Nagano City)

The park opens in late April, and skunk cabbages are in full bloom until mid-May, when you can also enjoy the fresh greenery of the beech forests.






Shiga-kogen Highlands (Yamanouchi Town)
