How to get to Málaga

Málaga is one of the best-connected Spanish cities.

Just 8 km from the city, it is the third biggest Spanish airport in terms of air traffic after Madrid and Barcelona, with more than 60 airlines operating from its facilities and more than 150 connections to different domestic and international destinations. It has an executive terminal that services all types of private aviation activities: executive charter flights, private jets, sports flights, etc.

Its port, which has 3 cruise terminals and some of the most modern maritime facilities in the country, is currently host to the largest shipping companies in the world.

Moreover, IGY Málaga Marina opened in July 2022, a modern yacht marina offering 31 berths for luxury yachts of between 50 and 100 metres in length.

Finally, its train station is one of the most important railway communication hubs in Andalusia, linking Málaga to the main Spanish cities through the High Speed (AVE) network.

Exclusive Accommodation

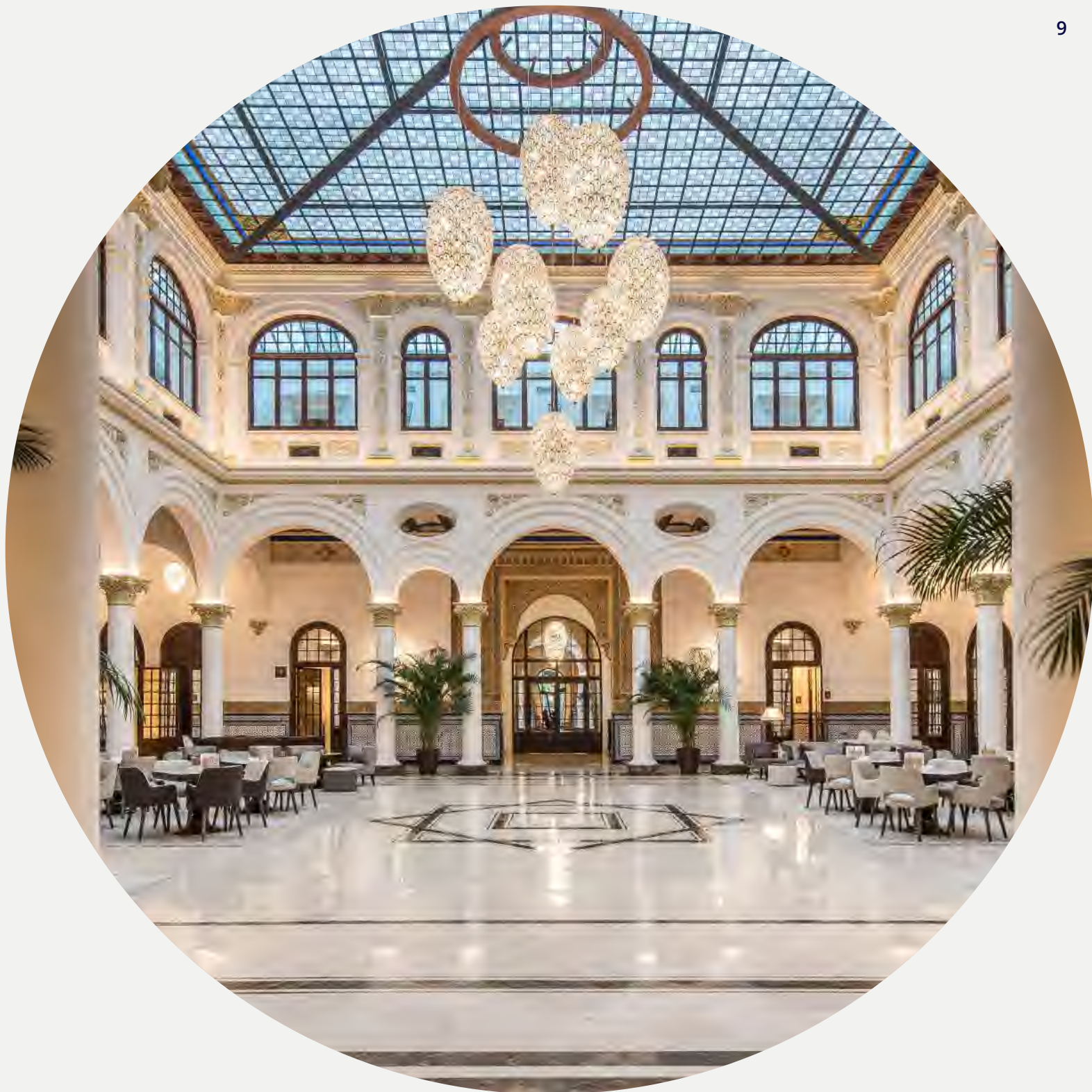
Málaga's select hotel offer is the epitome of elegance, where attentive service and first-class amenities merge to create an unforgettable stay.

Whether for experienced golfers or beginners wishing to learn, Málaga's courses offer a truly pleasurable experience in harmony with the pleasant Mediterranean climate.







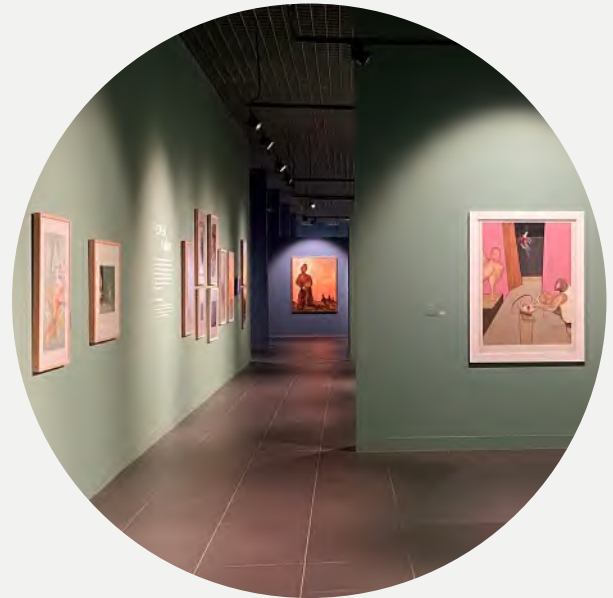
Málaga, the city of museums

Many of these museums offer exclusive visits with personalised attention and even intimate dinners where a unique blend of gastronomy and art is created.

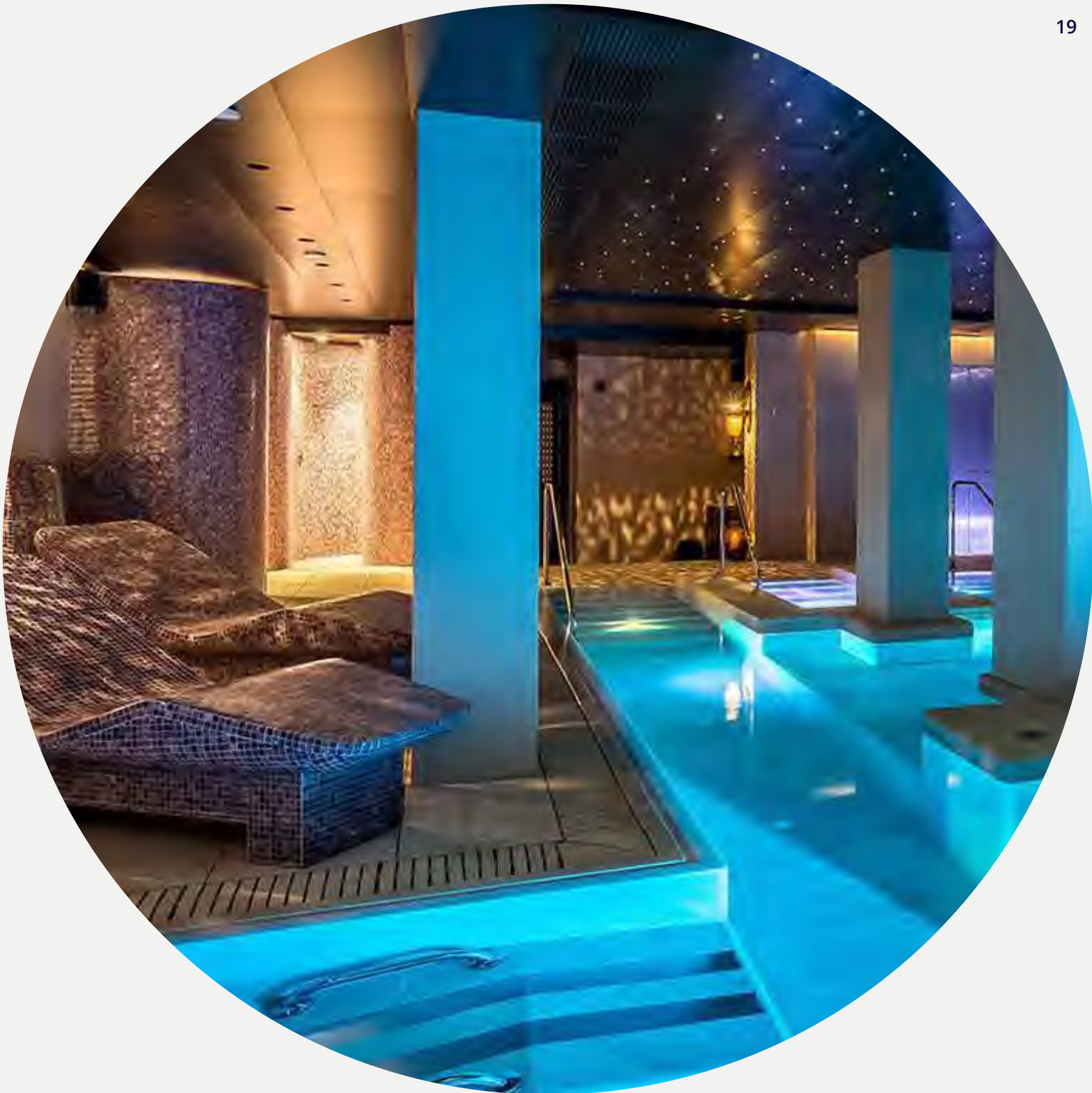


Relaxation, health and well-being

Perfect venues for special occasions

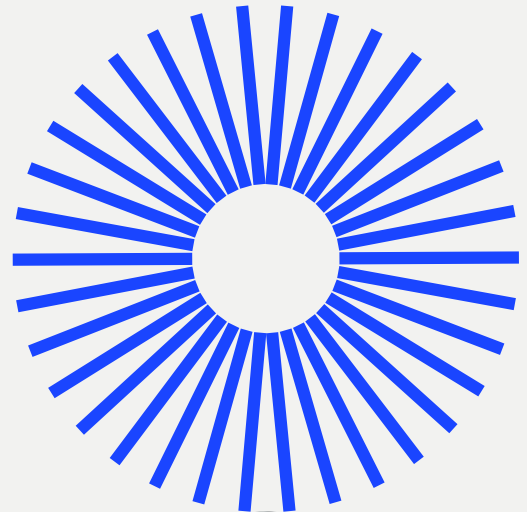
