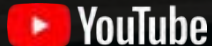

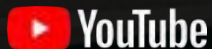
A Buddhist sect that chants the mantra “ *Nam Myoho Renge Kyo* ”



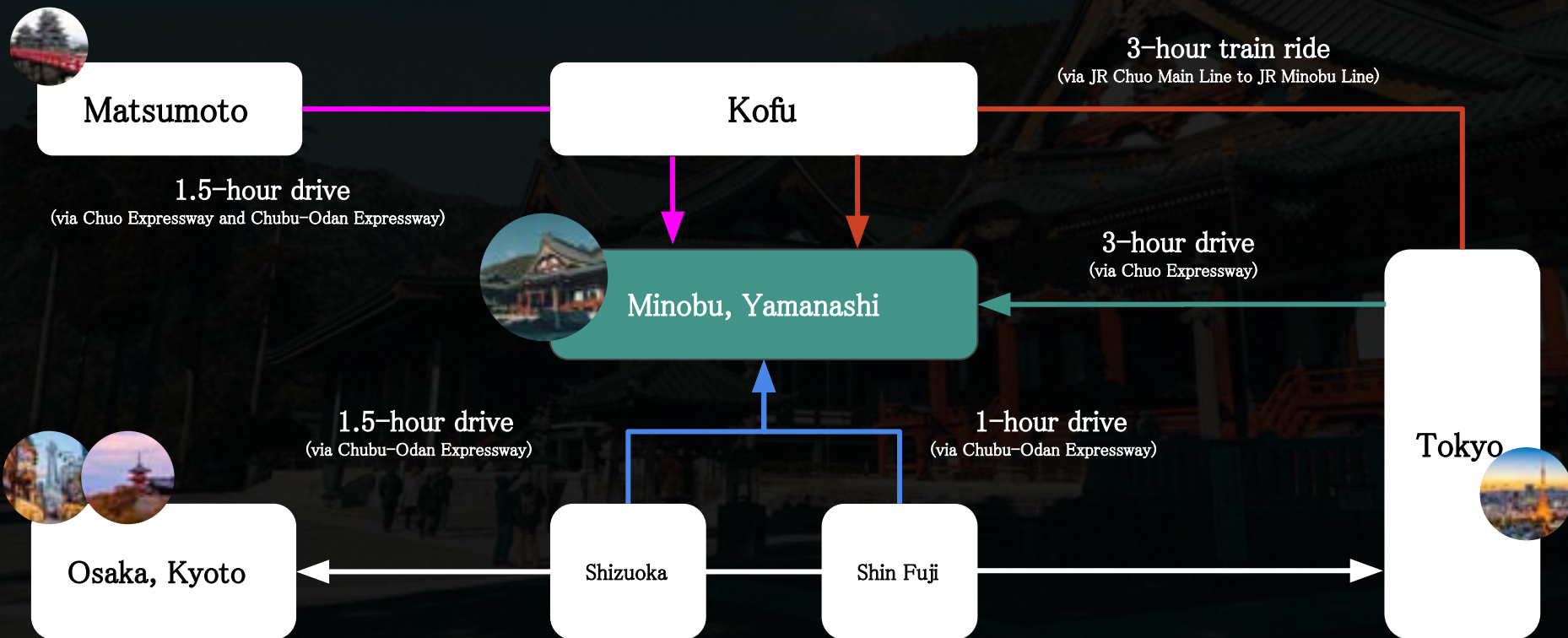

At Kuonji Temple, the head temple of the Nichiren sect on Mount Minobu, guests can participate in a spiritual journey beginning with the resonant ringing of the great bell tower at dawn, followed by the morning service in the main hall, and guided tours of the temple grounds.

Through these experiences, participants engage with the core teaching of the sect's mantra, "Nam Myoho Renge Kyo" (Lotus Sutra), embracing the practice of "living fully in the present moment to open the heart and lead a happy life."

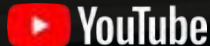

Meet the Artist: Professional Taiko Drummer and Director

Shunichiro Kamiya

Shunichiro Kamiya is a versatile taiko and traditional Japanese music artist, composer, and educator based in the Tokai region. Formerly a member of the renowned taiko ensemble Kodo, based on Niigata's Sado Island until 2017, he has since expanded his artistic reach through performances of *taiko* (Japanese drums), *shinobue* (bamboo flute), and folk dance. In addition to live performance, Shunichiro composes music, contributes original works, and leads workshops, fostering the next generation of artists.

His collaborative spirit extends beyond traditional Japanese music, engaging with diverse artists worldwide. He has toured extensively across Japan, the United States, Canada, Brazil, France, Spain, China, Myanmar, Australia, and more, with over 1,000 theater performances to his credit.

Shunichiro's distinguished collaborations include performances with Living National Treasure Tamasaburo Bando, conductor Tatsuya Shimono, and cellist Yunosuke Yamamoto. He was a featured traditional instrumentalist on J-pop artist AI's national "Wa to Yo" tour. Notably, Shunichiro made history as the first traditional Japanese musician invited to the Burning Man festival in the U.S., where he performed alongside renowned bondage artist Hajime Kinoko, blending traditional sound with contemporary performance art.

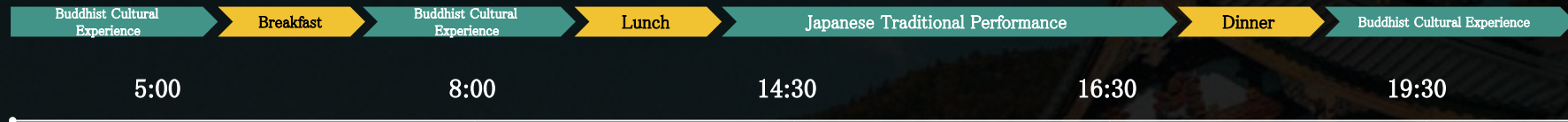

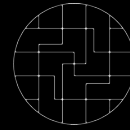
