Just 14 minutes by subway from Nagoya Station, the central train hub for Nagova, and 9 minutes from Sakae Station, this district once saw the promenades of wealthy merchants and cultural figures. Tamesaburo Memorial Museum: The former residence of Nagoya's leading tycoon, Furukawa Tamesaburo, featured in a famous American economic magazine



Yokiso Villa: The former estate of Ito Jirozaemon Suketami, the 15th president of Matsuzakaya Corporation, one of Japan's leading department stores



Furukawa Art Museum: This museum houses the collection of Nagoya's leading tycoon, Furukawa Tamesaburo, featured in a famous American economic magazine.




Sououji Temple: This temple is associated with the Tokugawa family, who ruled Japan about 400 years ago. The building dates back 350 years.



Nittaiji Temple: The only temple in Japan that houses the genuine relics of Buddha, transcending sectarian boundaries











Shiroyama Hachimangu Shrine and Showa Jukudo: Located at the site of a mountain castle associated with the famous warlord



Oda Nobunaga. The remnants of the moat are still visible. Showa Jukudo is an educational facility on the premises, dating back about 100 years.
