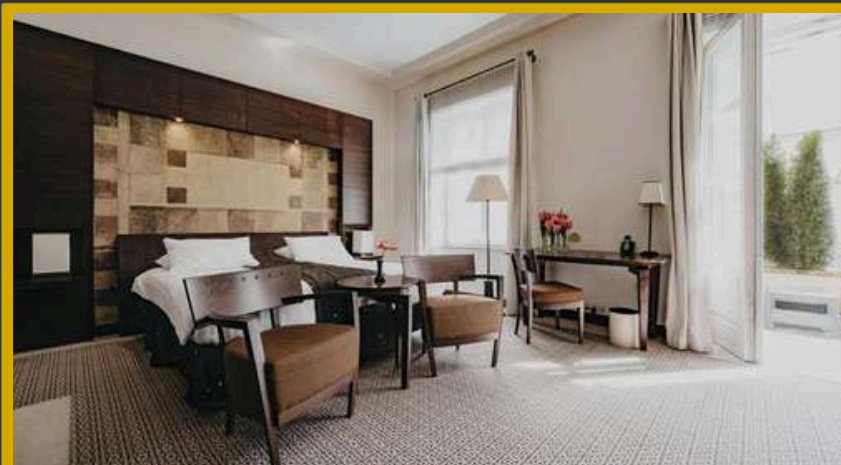

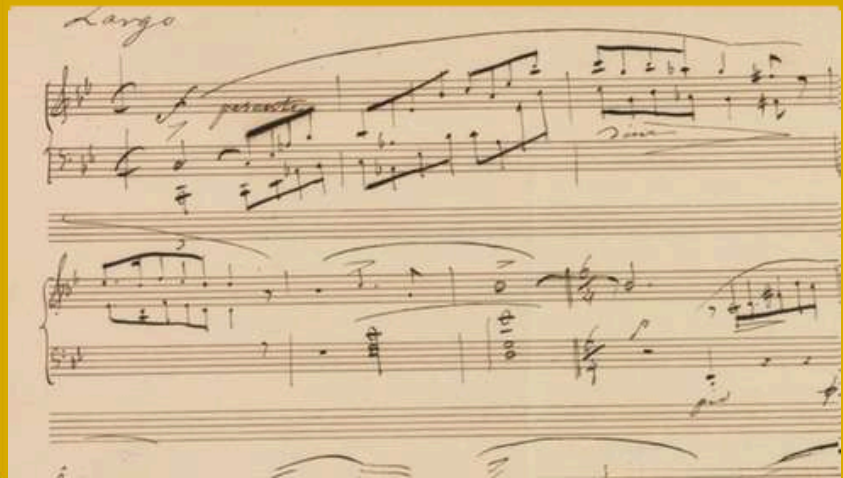


browar warszawski

Łazienki palace & park

The park features architectural highlights like the Royal Theatre, the Roman-inspired Amphitheater, and the Chopin Monument, surrounded by rose gardens and hosting summer piano concerts. The White Pavilion and Old Orangery display classicist design and house a sculpture gallery and restored theater. Lush gardens, including the English Garden and Chinese Garden, create scenic paths and tranquil spaces, complemented by wildlife like peacocks and squirrels. Each season offers a unique charm, from vibrant spring blooms to serene winter snows.

belvedere restaurant

wedel chocolate museum



The museum –Wedel Chocolate Factory –has opened its interiors in autumn 2024. The capital's future sweet showpiece. „*The E. Wedel brand has always been associated with Warsaw alluding to the history of the Wedel family, who were among the founders of chocolate history in Poland. Through interactive exhibitions, scents, flavours and textures, we inspire the senses and share our passion for chocolate, allowing our guests to discover the secrets of the unique process of its creation,*” says Robert Zydland and adds that the aroma of chocolate floating in the air will navigate the emerging museum. Wedel has been present in Warsaw's Kamionek since the 1930s, when Jan Wedel, Emil's son and grandson of Karol, the company's founder, built a production facility here. The factory has remained at the heart of the production of the iconic sweets ever since.

der elefant
