Day 1

ARRIVE IN KRAKOW

Check-in at Galaxy Hotel **** (or other hotel)

Afternoon – Hop On Hop Off Bus city tour

Dinner at the hotel

Day 2

KRAKOW

Breakfast at the hotel

9:00 – 12:00 a guided tour of Old Town with a local city guide

12:00 – 13:30 lunch (independent, e.g. in Miód Malina, Wierzynek, Chłopskie Jadło, Szara Gęś)

14:00 – 16:00 Wawel Hill and Wawel Castle (guided tour)

16:00 free time

optional: **19:00** a live performance of Chopin's music, followed by dinner at a restaurant

Day 3

KRAKOW

Breakfast at the hotel

9:00 – 13:00 a guided city tour of Kazimierz and Podgórze Districts

13 – 15:00 lunch (independent; Kazimierz is full of great places to eat)

15:00 – 17:30 Schindler's Factory visit with a guide

18:00 – 20:00 dinner at a restaurant (e.g. Klezmer Hois accompanied by a live Klezmer music performance, Emalia Zabłocie, Plan Nowy 1, Fala)

Day 4

WIELICZKA

Breakfast at the hotel

9:00 - 13:00 visit to the Salt Mine in Wieliczka (with transfers) – a unique UNESCO World Heritage Site

13:00 – 14:30 lunch at the Miner's Tavern – a restaurant in the Salt Mine, 125 metres below the surface in the Witold Budryk chamber

15:30 return to the hotel

15:30 – 18:00 free time for activities such as shopping (a shopping mall is located right next to the hotel) or taking a stroll around Kazimierz, with its cafes, street food, and small local shops

18:00 dinner at the hotel or a restaurant

Day 5

AUSCHWITZ MUSEUM

Breakfast at the hotel

9:00 - 16:00 visit to the Auschwitz-Birkenau Museum (with transfers)

16:00 return to the hotel

19:00 dinner at the hotel/restaurant

Day 6

TATRA MOUNTAINS AND PIENINY

Breakfast at the hotel

8:00 departure from Krakow to Szczawnica - a charming spa town known for its picturesque surroundings and healing mineral waters

10:30 – 13:00 arrive in Szczawnica and enjoy a scenic rafting trip on the Dunajec River, which offers breathtaking views of the Pieniny Mountains and the surrounding natural beauty

13:00 – 14:30 a traditional Polish lunch at a local restaurant in Szczawnica

14:30 – departure for Zakopane, the winter capital of Poland, nestled at the foot of the Tatra Mountains

16:00 – 17:30 arrive in Zakopane and explore Krupówki Street, the heart of the town, filled with shops, cafes, and traditional highlander culture

20:00 dinner at the hotel back in Krakow
