7. Tour to western (9 days)

OVERVIEW

This 9-day journey takes you deep into Mongolia’s far west to explore the majestic Altai Tavan Bogd National Park. Experience the culture of Kazakh nomads, hike to glaciers and sacred peaks, and enjoy breathtaking views at the crossroads of Mongolia, Russia, China, and Kazakhstan. A perfect mix of adventure, culture, and untouched nature.

DAY 1: Arrival in Ulaanbaatar

Arrival at Chinggis Khaan International airport and transfer to hotel, check-in.
Activies: Visit Chinggis Khaan Museum and experience traditional Mongolian music and dance performances at the Mongolian National Folk Song and Dance Ensemble

DAY 2: Fly to Bayan-Ulgii

Our driver meets you at your hotel and transfer to the airport for a flight to Ulgii, a central town of Bayan-Ulgii province. Land in Ulgii after 3 hours of flight. Meet your local guide and driver. Have a short tour of the provincial center town Ulgii and the journey continues to a Kazakh family.

DAY 3: Valley in Altai Tavan Bogd National Park

Drive to the Altai Tavan Bogd National Park through picturesque valleys and along the Tsaagan Gol (White River). is part of the UNESCO World Heritage.

DAY 4: Trekking in Altai Tavan Bogd National Park

Start our trekking towards Potanin Glacier and The Tavan Bogd (means Holy Five Peaks) highest peaks in Mongolia – Khuiten Uul- 4374m, Peak Malchin, Peak Naran, Peak Burged and Peak Ulgii. Meaning the 5 Kings it comprises of five neighboring peaks. While trekking we will cross glaciers which connect those five peaks. Trekking distance 20km approx.



DAY 5: Hikking to Malchin peak

After breakfast we will go to 4th highest peak of Mongolia “Malchin peak” which is more than 4000 meters higher from sea level. You can get easily on the top of that peak. From the top of Malchin you will have full view to Russian territory and long and breathtaking views to Kazakhstan’s and Chinese snow capped Altai mountains.



DAY 6: Go back Tsagaan gol

Trek back toward the Tsagaan Gol valley while enjoying the dramatic scenery. Camp along the riverbank for a peaceful night under the stars.

DAY 7: Drive back to Ulgii

Drive back to Ulgii. On the way, visit any remaining cultural sites or markets. Spend the night at a guesthouse or hotel in town and enjoy a farewell Kazakh dinner.

DAY 8: Fly back Ulaanbaatar

Take a return flight to Ulaanbaatar. Upon arrival, check into your hotel. The rest of the day is free for shopping or relaxing.

DAY 9: Departure

Transfer to the airport for your international departure.

About fishing in Uur river:

Although Mongolia is, quite rightly, associated with vast steppes, green plains and the Gobi desert, its Northern provinces have been home to some of the highest mountain chains in the world, and glaciers. Some of the mountain tops in Huvsgul province, where our Mongolian fishing expedition starts, reach over 3,500m, like the tallest mountain top in Tagniin nuruu chain.

That's where one of the best world's Taimen Rivers, the Uur river, starts its run to later feed the famous Selenge River, which follows towards Baikal lake. Uur river is known to be the world's best Taimen River.

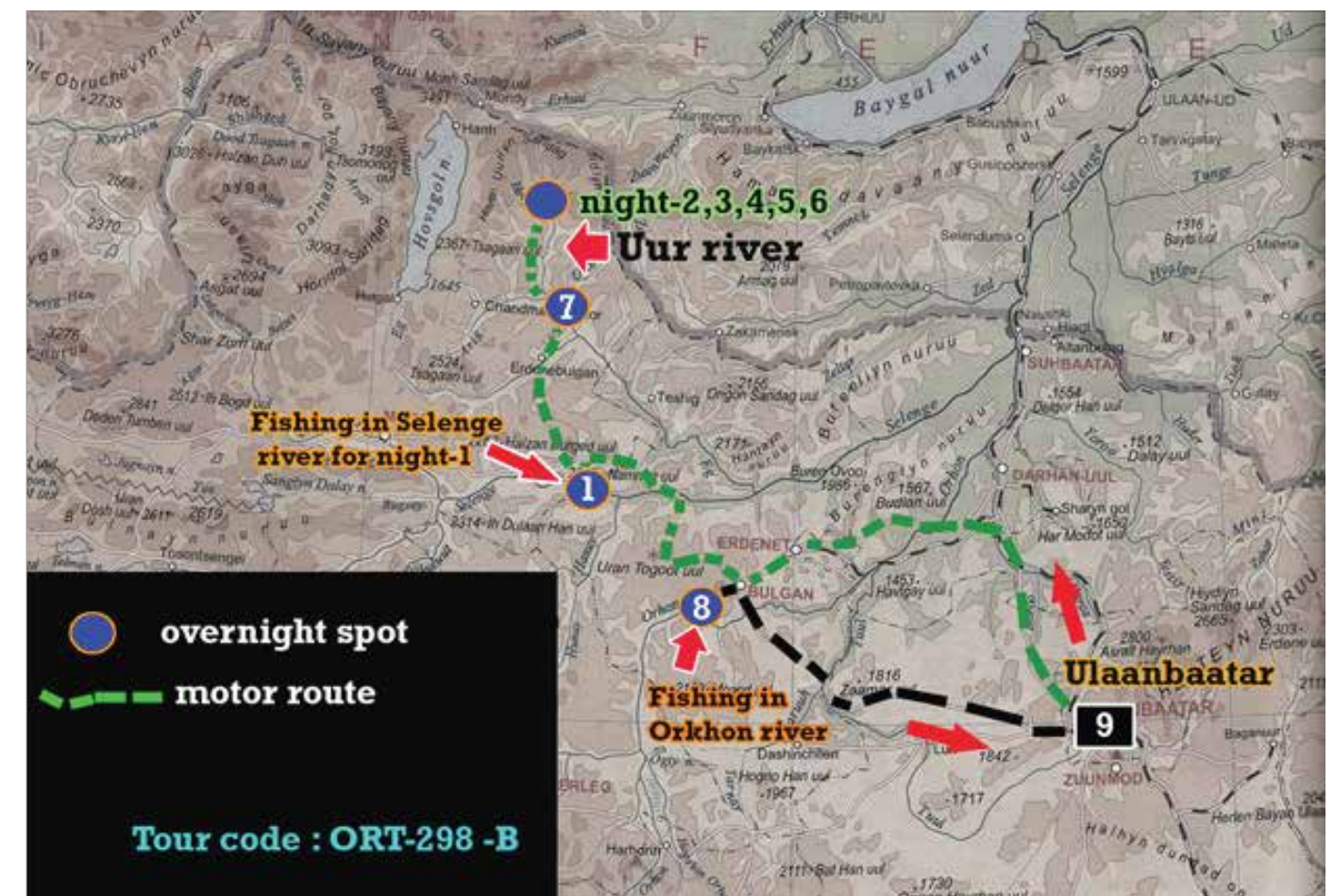
Transportation:

Our main transports are Japanese Land cruiser -80 ,100, 105 jeeps support by Russian UAZ furgon or GAZ-66 truck in order to carry our food and other outdoor camping stuff.

Target Species :

Taimen : Mongolian Taimen

The Hucho taimen is the largest salmonid fish in the world; an exclusively freshwater fish found in Siberia and Mongolia. Now endangered over much of its range, healthy populations can still be found in remote parts of Russia and Mongolia. Taimen are a long-lived fish, living to well over 30 years, but are found at relatively low population densities, as they are essentially a non-migratory fish. Their size, and slow growth rates make them susceptible to over-exploitation and ecosystem damage.

9. Khuvsgul lake & Reindeer tour (11 days)

This 11-day adventure takes you from the volcanic craters of Bulgan to the crystal-clear waters of Lake Khuvsgul, deep into the taiga to meet Mongolia’s reindeer herders, and across breathtaking alpine and volcanic landscapes. Experience traditional nomadic life, horse trekking, and pristine nature while staying in authentic ger camps and with local families.

ACTIVITIES

Hiking, Horse trekking into Taiga, Reindeer People, Khuvsgul lake,

DAY 1: Arrival in Ulaanbaatar

Arrival at Chinggis Khaan International airport and transfer to hotel, check-in.

Activies: Visit Chinggis Khaan Museum and experience traditional Mongolian music and dance performances at the Mongolian National Folk Song and Dance Ensemble

DAY 2: Uran Togoo Volcano

Drive to Uran Togoo in Bulgan Province. Hike to the crater and enjoy a picnic. Overnight at a ger camp.

DAY 3: Lake Khuvsgul

Travel to Lake Khuvsgul. Enjoy lakeside hikes and relaxation. Stay in a ger near the lake.



DAY 4: Meet Horse Herder Family

Drive deeper into Khuvsgul to meet a local horse herder family. Settle in and prepare for the horse trek. Overnight in a traditional ger.

DAY 5: Horse Trek to Reindeer Camp

Full-day horse trek through rugged taiga to reach the Tsaatan (Reindeer People). Picnic lunch en route. Stay in a private tent or with a Tsaatan family.

Terrain Warning: This will be a challenging journey with steep, rocky terrain through forested mountains.



Experience reindeer herding, try milking, and learn about Tsaatan traditions. Overnight in tent or host ger.

DAY 7: Return to Herder Camp

Trek back to the horse herder camp. Enjoy dinner and rest in a nearby ger camp.

DAY 8: Drive to Murun

Travel to Murun for fresh food, showers, and rest. Overnight in hotel or guesthouse.

DAY 9: Great White Lake & Khorgo Volcano

Drive to Terkhiin Tsagaan Lake and Khorgo Volcano. Explore trails and lava formations. Overnight in a ger camp.

DAY 10: Back to Ulaanbaatar

Return to Ulaanbaatar. Enjoy souvenir shopping and a relaxing final evening in the city.

DAY 1: Arrival in Ulaanbaatar

Arrival at Chinggis Khaan International airport and transfer to hotel, check-in.

Activities: Visit Chinggis Khaan Museum and experience traditional Mongolian music and dance performances at the Mongolian National Folk Song and Dance Ensemble

DAY 2: Ride to Elsen Tasarkhai (Mongol Els Sand Dunes)

Transfer out of the city by bus, receive your motorcycle, and begin riding to Elsen Tasarkhai dunes. Overnight in a ger camp. (~280 km)

DAY 3: Ride to Erdene Zuu Monastery

Continue riding west to the historic Erdene Zuu Monastery, one of Mongolia's oldest Buddhist centers. (~150 km)

DAY 4: Ride to Tayhar (Tamir River)

Visit the monastery and ride along gravel roads to Tayhar, enjoying scenic views along the Tamir River. (~200 km)

DAY 5: Ride to Terkhiin Tsagaan Lake

Head toward the volcanic region of Khorgo and arrive at the beautiful White Lake. (~155 km)

DAY 6: Ride to Zurkh Lake

Ride north through rugged terrain to reach the remote Zurkh Lake region. (~300 km)

Day 7: Ride to Khuvsgul Lake

Journey toward Mongolia's crystal-clear Khuvsgul Lake, passing by the Khoridol Saridag Mountains. (~250 km)

Day 8 & 9: Rest at Khuvsgul Lake

Relax, explore the lake's alpine beauty, visit local families, or enjoy optional short rides. Explore Tsaatan culture, take a boat ride, or unwind in nature.

Day 10: Ride to Murun Town

Ride a short distance to the provincial center Murun for a more comfortable overnight stay. (~100 km)

Day 11: Flight to Ulaanbaatar

Transfer to Murun Airport and fly back to Ulaanbaatar. No riding today.

Day 12: Departure

Transfer to the airport for your international flight. Farewell Mongolia!

DAY 1

Depart Ulaanbaatar and journey eastward to the legendary Chinggis Khaan Statue Complex. Marvel at the towering 40-meter monument, climb up to the horse’s head for panoramic views, and visit the onsite museum to learn about Mongolia’s great unifier.

Continue your journey to the immersive 13th Century Complex, where time slows down. Walk through six themed camps representing life in the Mongol Empire—from the King’s Palace and Shamanic rituals to herding life and military strategy. Traditional costumes, ancient tools, and authentic settings bring history vividly to life.

In the late afternoon, arrive at your cozy ger camp nestled in Terelj’s winter wilderness. Warm up by the stove, enjoy a hearty Mongolian dinner, and rest in a private ger under starry skies.



DAY 2

Wake up to crisp mountain air and a hot local breakfast before embarking on a thrilling dog sledding experience. Glide across frozen landscapes led by a professional musher and a spirited team of huskies.

After the ride, explore Terelj National Park’s winter beauty. Visit the famous Turtle Rock formation and hike to the serene Ariyabal Meditation Temple, perched on a hilltop with sweeping valley views.

Optional activity: Horseback riding along the Tuul River is available for those seeking more adventure.

Enjoy a warm lunch at the ger camp before heading back to Ulaanbaatar. Arrive in the late afternoon and conclude your winter escape with lasting memories of Mongolia’s snow-covered charm.
