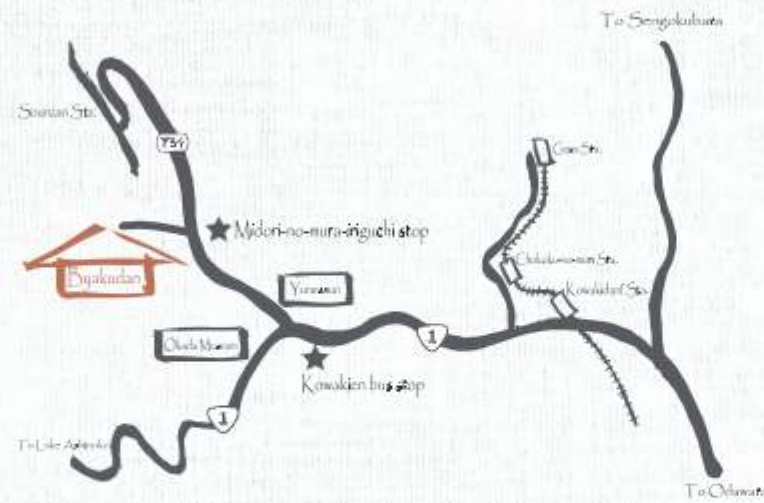
Gora hot springs at Gen

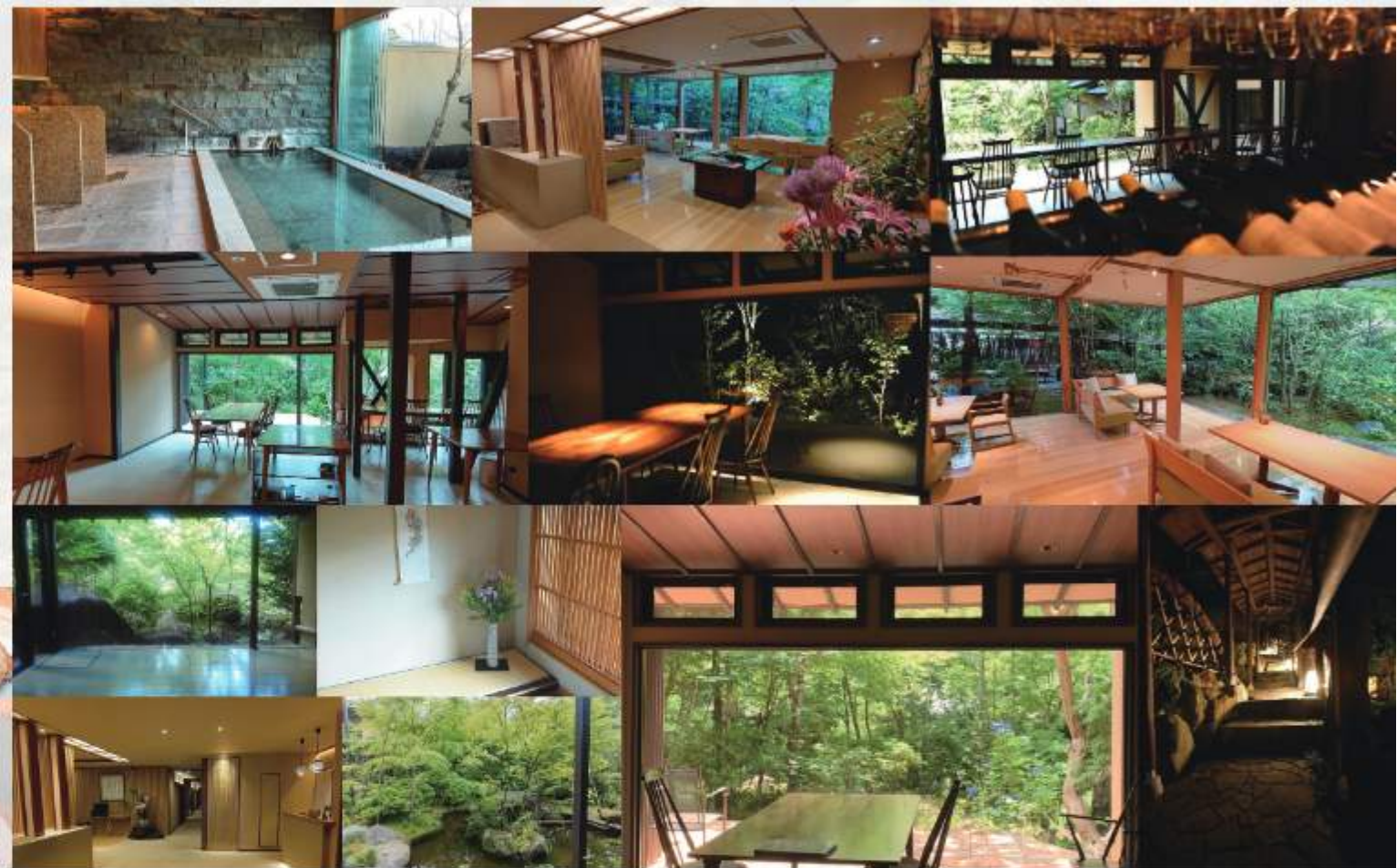

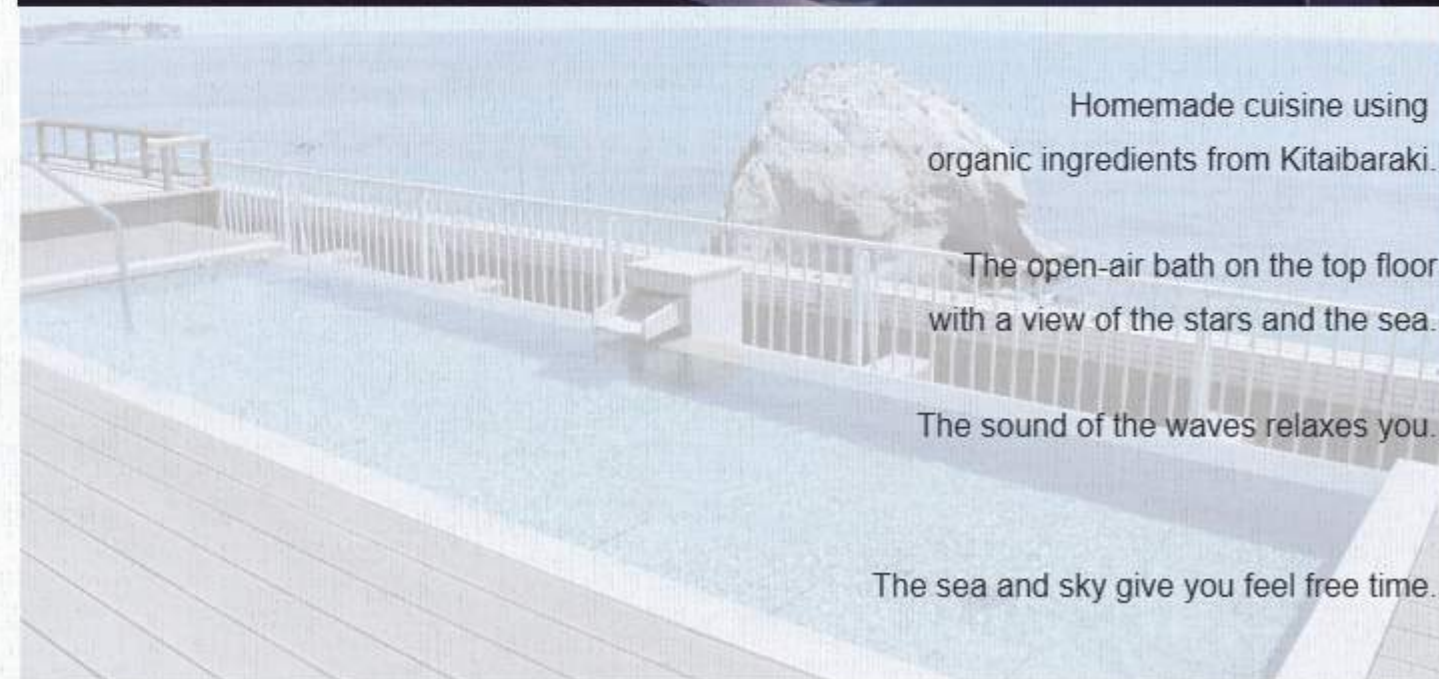

Onsen

Our hot springs are natural hot springs that spring from our own land. The hotel has a "panoramic view public hot spring" with large windows from which you can see the Pacific Ocean stretching out before you and fishing fires twinkling in the distance at night! On the roof of the hotel, there is an "Ocean & Sky View Open-air Bath" where you can enjoy the early morning sunrise, the bright blue sky during the day, and the star-filled sky at night. Please enjoy the high quality hot spring with the sound of the waves lapping the ocean.

All rooms at Isohara Seaside Hotel are "oceanfront rooms" which are faced to Pacific Ocean and the rooms where you can enjoy the sound of waves as background music. The large windows in the rooms overlook the horizon of the Pacific Ocean. At night, Futatsushima, the symbol of the Isohara Coast lit up, is right in front of you. Lying on the bed or futon, you will feel as if you are on the sea.

Dinner

Homemade local organic ingredients

Our dinners are based on Japanese cuisine, blending elements of cuisines from various countries. We use only organic ingredients and carefully select locally grown seasonal produce with the cooperation of our producers to ensure that our guests can experience the fascination of Ibaraki's food. All vegetables are organically grown by local contract farmers. Fresh seafood landed at the local port is used, and meat is also carefully selected to be grown naturally. Miso, salted malt, bread, dressing, and jam are all handmade in the hotel from scratch. The rice is also grown naturally by contracted farmers, and we do not use any pre-made products.



Breakfast

Fresh and nutritious homemade breakfast

Breakfast is mainly handmade organic side dishes. Natto (Fermented Soybeans), a specialty of Ibaraki Prefecture, is served with 10 different toppings and 4 different sauces. Furthermore, rice is made from "Koshihikari" varieties grown with reduced pesticides in northern Ibaraki, a delicious "fisherman's soup" with fresh fish meat and bones, homemade bread, and homemade yogurt and jam are also available.
