According to legend, Takanosu Onsen was discovered in 1806 (Bunka period 3). Boatmen traveling up and down the Arakawa River noticed a hawk constantly flapping its wings and bathing in a spring by the riverbank.

Intrigued, they investigated further and found the spring had disappeared. Villagers then built a makeshift bath using stones.

Later, in 1891 (Meiji 24), Mr. Zensaku Saito, a resident of Shimonoseki in this village, purchased all the shares of the Takanosu hot spring and named it "Takanosu-kan," marking the beginning of our inn.
