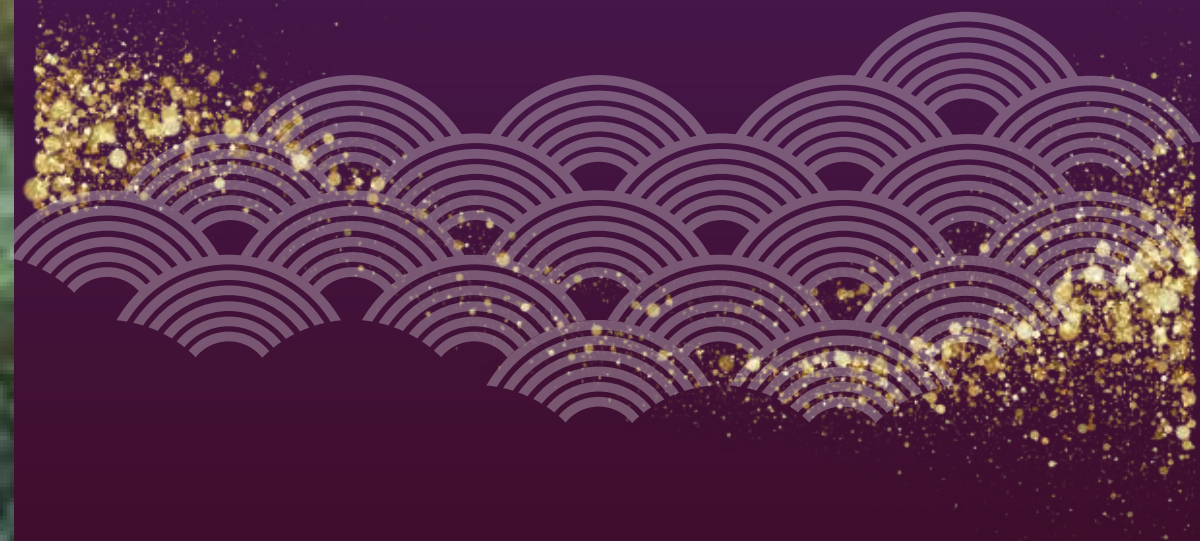

Starting from our large dressing room, guests can enjoy selecting a kimono from variety of designs, and then participating in a traditional tea ceremony led by a professional host. Kimono rental, matcha green tea and Japanese sweets are all included in the plan, and all the sessions are given in English. We also have various types of plans for our guests' "once in a lifetime" events.

Samurai Ninja Museum -with experience-



Samurai Ninja Museum is an experience-based museum with authentic samurai and ninja related exhibits from various ages. The museum section features real samurai armor with over a hundred years of history, a collection of well-preserved samurai swords and the variety of unique ninja equipment on display.

During the guided tour, visitors can touch some of the swords and equipment to feel the weight and the craftsmanship directly.

Also available are Japanese sword lessons, Ninja trainings and Real armor try-on for deeper understanding of legendary warriors.

Collection of real armor and Japanese swords

Our museum features real samurai armor with over a hundred years of history, and a collection of well-preserved samurai swords. During the guided tour, you can even touch some of the swords and equipment to feel the weight and the craftsmanship directly.

Authentic activities to feel the spirit of Japanese legendary warriors

We deliver Japanese sword lessons in which you wear traditional samurai attire (hakama) and practice katana with our expert trainer.

For the history fans who seek for further intensive experiences, we also offer “Real Armor Try-on.” You can put on real samurai armor and pose for professional photo shootings.



Family-friendly entertainment

We offer authentic, but easy to participate ninja trainings for all ninja fans. The journey starts from wearing ninja attire, and you will learn various types of shuriken and blow-gun techniques. Popular for both kids and adults.

Kyoto is famous for its peaceful environment with Buddhist temples and shinto shrines, yet if you want to experience an energetic part of history with legendary warriors, our museum would be one of the best choices to add to the itinerary.

Exhibits of real armor, Japanese swords and ninja equipment are available at both branches, yet to reflect the ambience of each city, our Shinjuku museum displays collections of real armor with beautiful projection mapping, while in Asakusa we focus on the traditional style showcase.

We also boast our experienced sword trainers- one is a master of Iai-do and a descendant of real samurai.

Both venues are easily accessible from the nearest stations, and easy to drop by during your Tokyo trip.
