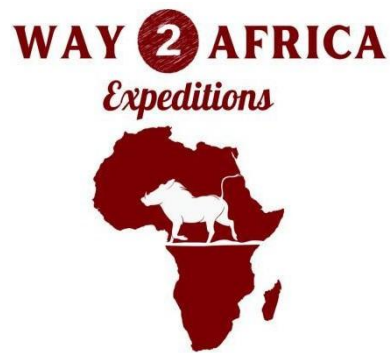
<i>DAY</i>	<i>ITINERARY</i>
<i>Day 1</i>	<i>Arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport and Transfer to Arusha</i> Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport, you are warmly greeted by a Above and Beyond Photographic Tours & Safaris representative who will assist you with your luggage and provide a private transfer to Arusha. The distance from JRO to Arusha is approximately 55 km, taking about 1 hour depending on traffic. The drive passes through small villages, open plains, and stunning views of Mount Meru as you approach the city. Your accommodation will be at Four Points by Sheraton Arusha, a renowned luxury hotel offering excellent service, spacious suites, a swimming pool, gym, and a refined dining atmosphere. Mid-range alternatives include Forest Hills Hotel and Ritzy Arcadia Cottages, both known for comfort, cleanliness, and warm service. Spend the rest of the day relaxing, enjoying the hotel gardens, or exploring Arusha city at your leisure. Extra activities available: Arusha city tour, Tanzanite shopping experience, Coffee farm visit, Cultural Heritage Centre visit, spa treatments
<i>Day 2</i>	<i>Tarangire National Park</i> After breakfast, leave Arusha and drive to Tarangire National Park, located approximately 120 km away, taking about 2 to 2.5 hours. Tarangire is famous for its towering baobab trees, vast golden landscapes, and the largest elephant population in northern Tanzania. Covering 2,850 square kilometers, Tarangire offers excellent habitat for lions, buffaloes, giraffes, zebras, wildebeests, cheetahs, and more than 450 species of birds. Your extensive game drive takes you through river valleys, acacia forests, and open savannas where wildlife gathers around the Tarangire River during most parts of the year. For the luxury package, you will stay at Serian Tarangire Luxury Camp, an exclusive property offering comfort, gourmet meals, and breathtaking views. Mid-range options include Tarangire Sopa Lodge or Tarangire Safari Lodge, known for their prime viewing locations. Extra activities available: Night game drive (in nearby Wildlife Management Area), guided walking safari, sundowner setup overlooking the Tarangire River.



Day 3 	Central Serengeti National Park You depart Tarangire after breakfast and head toward the world-famous Serengeti National Park. The distance to the Central Serengeti is approximately 250 km, and the journey takes 5 to 6 hours, passing through the Great Rift Valley, Karatu highlands, and the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Your entry into the Serengeti marks the beginning of an incredible wildlife viewing experience. Central Serengeti, especially the Seronera Valley, is known for its permanent water sources that attract large concentrations of predators including lions, cheetahs, leopards, hyenas, and a wide variety of herbivores. Afternoon game drives allow you to witness active wildlife interactions. Luxury accommodation options include Kubu Kubu Tented Lodge or Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge, both offering panoramic views and premium comfort. Mid-range choices include Moyo Tented Camp, Anantya Camp, or Signature Serengeti Camp. Extra activities available: Sunrise hot air balloon safari, Serengeti bush dinner, professional wildlife photography sessions, Serengeti Visitor Centre visit.
Day 4 	Northern Serengeti National Park After an early breakfast, drive to the stunning Northern Serengeti, covering approximately 155 km with a travel time of 4 to 5 hours depending on wildlife sightings en route. The Northern Serengeti is celebrated for its remote landscapes, rolling hills, lush riverine forests, and the spectacular Mara River, the center of the Great Wildebeest Migration river crossings. This region offers exceptional opportunities to witness dramatic wildlife encounters, including thousands of wildebeests and zebras attempting to cross the river while crocodiles lurk below. Luxury accommodation will be at Mara River Camp, a high-end camp located near key river crossing points. Mid-range options include Nyikani Migration Camp and Untamed Migration Camp, both offering excellent locations and great service. Extra activities available: Guided nature walks, sundowner experiences on scenic kopjes, specialized migration tracking.



<i>Day 5</i>	<i>Northern Serengeti National Park</i> You will spend a full day exploring the Northern Serengeti in search of migration herds, predators, and river activity. Full-day game drives allow you to follow wildlife movement along the riverbanks, open plains, and woodland edges, offering unforgettable photographic opportunities. The Northern Serengeti is one of Tanzania's least crowded regions, ensuring peaceful and authentic wilderness experiences. Animals commonly seen include lions, elephants, cheetahs, leopards, zebra herds, topi, hippos, and Nile crocodiles. Overnight at Mara River Camp or mid-range options Nyikani Migration Camp and Untamed Migration Camp. Extra activities available: Morning balloon safari when available, riverside sundowner, Maasai cultural visit.
<i>Day 6</i>	<i>Drive Back to Central Serengeti</i> After breakfast, return to the Central Serengeti, covering approximately 155 km with a 4 to 5 hour journey. This drive allows additional sightings of wildlife migrating north or south depending on the season, along with predator activity along the Seronera River. Afternoon game drives reveal classic Serengeti wildlife including lions, hyenas, elephants, buffaloes, gazelles, and an impressive variety of bird species. Luxury accommodation for this night is Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge, a beautifully designed lodge perched on a hill with panoramic views. Mid-range options include Moyo Tented Camp, Anantya Camp, or Signature Serengeti Camp. Extra activities available: Sunset viewpoint visit, Maasai cultural experience, campfire storytelling with guides.
<i>Day 7</i>	<i>Ngorongoro Crater</i> After breakfast, depart for the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, a journey of about 150 km taking 3 to 4 hours. Upon arrival, descend into the Ngorongoro Crater for a spectacular game drive lasting 5 to 6 hours. The crater floor is home to more than 25,000 large mammals in a self-sustaining ecosystem with grasslands, soda lakes, acacia forests, and marshes. It is one of the best places in Tanzania to spot the endangered black rhino, as well as large prides of lions, massive buffalo herds, elephants, hippos, wildebeests, zebras, and countless birds. You will stay overnight at Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge, perched on the



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	crater rim with breathtaking views. Mid-range choices include Embalakai Ngorongoro Camp, Angata Ngorongoro Camp, or Ngorongoro Wild Camp. Extra activities available: Crater rim nature walk, Maasai village visit, crater rim sundowner experience.
Day 8	Departure After breakfast, you will be transferred from Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge to Kilimanjaro International Airport. The distance is approximately 200 km, taking 4 to 4.5 hours depending on traffic and road conditions. This marks the end of your breathtaking 8-day Tanzania Serena luxury safari with Way 2 Africa Expeditions.

Day 1	Arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport After breakfast, you will depart for Arusha National Park, located just 35 km from Arusha town, with a driving time of approximately 45 minutes. Despite its compact size, the park offers remarkable scenic diversity including lush montane forests, open savanna's, crater lakes, and the dramatic backdrop of Mount Meru. Game drives reveal giraffes, buffaloes, zebras, warthogs, and numerous primate species such as colobus monkeys. The park is also a bird lover's paradise, home to flamingos and over 400 bird species. Extra activities available Guided walking safari Canoeing on Momella Lakes Birdwatching excursions
Day 2	Arusha National Park After breakfast, you will depart for Arusha National Park, located just 35 kilometers from Arusha town, with a driving time of approximately 45 minutes. Day 3

Tarangire National Park

Today you will drive approximately **120 kms**, taking about **2 to 3 hours**, to Tarangire National Park, famous for its massive elephant herds and ancient baobab trees. The Tarangire River acts as a vital water source, attracting large concentrations of wildlife including lions, leopards, wildebeest, and a wide variety of bird species. Game drives here offer exceptional wildlife photography opportunities, especially during the dry season.

Day 4

Drive from Tarangire to Lake Natron

After breakfast, you will embark on a scenic journey of approximately **200 kilometers**, taking **5 to 6 hours**, toward the remote and striking Lake Natron region. This area lies at the base of the active Ol Doinyo Lengai volcano, revered by the Maasai people. The drive passes through traditional Maasai villages and rugged landscapes rarely visited by tourists. Upon arrival, you will enjoy breathtaking views of the alkaline lake, known as a major breeding ground for flamingos.

Sunset viewing at the lake



Day 5	<i>Full Day Lake Natron Exploration</i> Spend a full day exploring Lake Natron and its surroundings. Activities include a guided hike to the Ngare Sero Waterfalls, a scenic trek through narrow gorges leading to a refreshing natural pool. Explore the lake's shoreline, an important breeding ground for flamingos, and learn about the unique ecosystem shaped by volcanic minerals. The day also offers insight into traditional Maasai culture and daily life in this remote region. Extra activities available include cultural storytelling with Maasai elders, volcano viewpoints, and extended nature walks.
Day 6	<i>Drive from Lake Natron to Northern Serengeti via Klein's Gate</i> Depart Lake Natron and drive approximately 260 kilometers to the Northern Serengeti, entering the park through Klein's Gate. The journey takes around 6 to 7 hours, passing through dramatic landscapes and remote wilderness areas. Upon entering the Serengeti, enjoy a game drive en route to your camp. The Northern Serengeti is known for its wide-open plains, resident predators, and seasonal Great Migration activity. Extra activities available include specialized photographic game drives and guided bush walks near camp.
Day 7	<i>Full Day Northern Serengeti Exploration</i> Enjoy a full day of game drives in the Northern Serengeti, focusing on wildlife tracking and photography. The region offers excellent opportunities to see lions, elephants, giraffes, cheetahs, and large herds of grazing animals. Depending on the season, you may witness dramatic river crossings or large migratory herds. A picnic lunch allows for uninterrupted exploration of this remote wilderness. Extra activities available include hot air balloon safaris and extended sunrise or sunset game drives.



Day 8	<i>Return to Central Serengeti</i> After breakfast, drive approximately 250 kilometers in 5 to 6 hours to the Central Serengeti Seronera Area. The journey offers changing landscapes and wildlife encounters along the way. The Seronera region is the most wildlife-rich area of the Serengeti, with permanent water sources attracting predators year-round. Enjoy an afternoon game drive upon arrival. Extra activities available include photography workshops and night game drives at selected camps.
Day 9	<i>Drive from Central Serengeti to Ngorongoro Conservation Area</i> Depart Central Serengeti and travel approximately 190 kilometers in 4 to 5 hours to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Enjoy scenic views of rolling plains and volcanic highlands. Upon arrival, take in panoramic views of the Ngorongoro Crater, one of Africa's most iconic natural wonders. Depending on timing, short exploration around the crater rim may be included. Extra activities available include Maasai village visits, guided nature walks, and cultural interactions.
Day 10	<i>Drive Back to Arusha for Domestic Flight to Zanzibar</i> After breakfast, drive approximately 180 kilometers back to Arusha, a journey of 3.5 to 4 hours. Upon arrival, transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to Zanzibar. On arrival, you will be transferred to your beach resort where the remainder of the day is spent relaxing by the ocean. Extra activities available include spa treatments, sunset dhow cruises, and beach walks.
Day 11-14	<i>Zanzibar Island Exploration and Relaxation</i> Spend four days exploring and relaxing on Zanzibar Island, famous for its pristine beaches, turquoise waters, and rich Swahili culture. Activities may include visiting Stone Town, spice farm tours, snorkeling, diving, and enjoying leisure time along the coast. These days are flexible and can be tailored to personal interests. Extra activities available include dolphin tours, deep sea fishing, kite surfing, and cultural village visits

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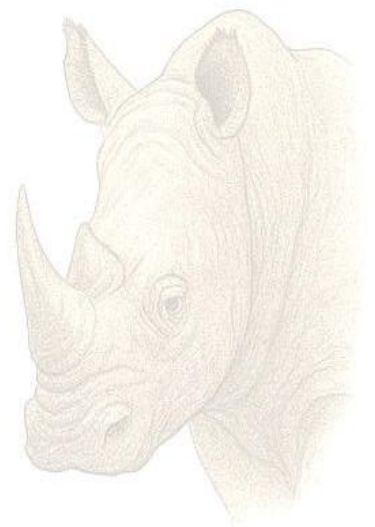
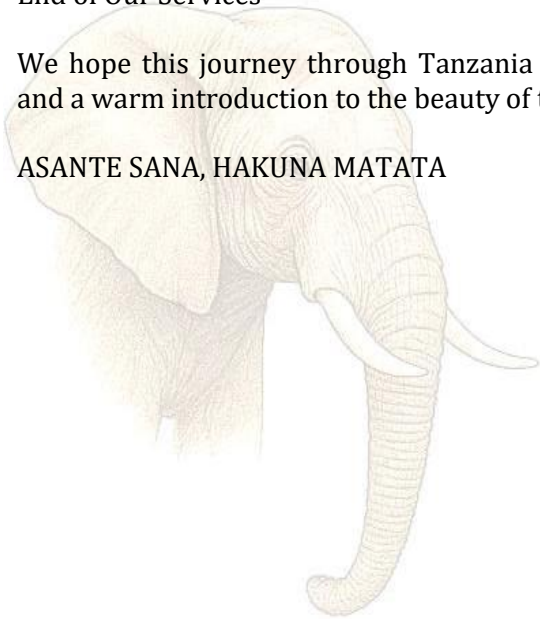

<i>Day 1</i>	<i>Arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport</i> Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport, your Way 2 Africa Expeditions driver guide will meet you for a warm welcome before transferring you to your first night's accommodation in Arusha. The drive takes approximately one hour, covering a distance of about 50 kilometers through the green landscapes of Mount Meru's foothills. Arusha is the premier safari hub of northern Tanzania, offering a peaceful environment to rest after your international journey. Guests staying at the luxurious Gran Melia Arusha enjoy modern amenities, a serene garden, spa, and stunning mountain views, while mid range travelers may stay at Forest Hills Hotel or Ritzy Arcadia Cottages for a comfortable and tranquil stay. Extra activities in Arusha include a city tour, a visit to the local coffee plantations, a Tanzanian cultural heritage visit, or a hike at the base of Mount Meru if time allows. <i>Day 2</i>	<i>Tarangire National Park</i> After breakfast, depart from Arusha for Tarangire National Park, located about 120 kilometers away, with a driving time of approximately three hours. Tarangire is one of Tanzania's most scenic parks, famous for its massive elephant herds, towering baobab trees, diverse bird-life, and dramatic landscapes shaped by the Tarangire River. During your game drive, you may encounter giraffes, zebras, lions, buffalo s, cheetahs, wildebeests, and impalas roaming the open plains. The river attracts wildlife year round, providing exceptional opportunities for photography and extended game viewing. Luxury travelers will stay at Escarpment Luxury Lodge or Moon-bow Lodge, both positioned to provide sweeping views and an elegant safari ambiance. Mid range guests stay at the highly rated Farm of Dreams Lodge in Karatu. Optional extra activities include a guided walking safari outside the park, a Maasai cultural boma visit, or an evening sundowner overlooking the Tarangire valley. After a full day of exploration, you return to your lodge for dinner and relaxation.



<i>Day 3</i> 	<i>Ngorongoro Crater</i> This morning, you drive from Tarangire to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, a journey of about two and a half hours covering approximately 150 kilometers. You descend 600 meters into the Ngorongoro Crater for a full day crater tour in what is considered one of the world's greatest natural wonders. The crater floor spans about 260 square kilometers and shelters an extraordinary concentration of wildlife including the Big Five lions, elephants, buffaloes, leopards, and the rare black rhinoceros. Permanent freshwater springs attract hippos, flamingos, zebras, wildebeests, hyenas, and jackals, creating a vibrant ecosystem that supports wildlife throughout the seasons. Luxury guests may stay in lodges such as Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge or Kubu Kubu Tented Lodge, while mid range options include Moyo Tented Camp, Anantya Camp, or Signature Serengeti Camp. Optional activities in the Ngorongoro area include a visit to a Maasai boma, a guided walking safari along the crater rim, or a cultural tour of local highland communities.
<i>Day 4</i> 	<i>Central Serengeti National Park</i> Today you travel from Ngorongoro towards the Central Serengeti, covering a distance of about 160 kilometers during a scenic four hour drive through the Ngorongoro highlands and into the endless plains of Serengeti National Park. Central Serengeti is famous for its abundant resident wildlife and is a key area for predator sightings including lions, cheetahs, leopards, and spotted hyenas. The Seronera River Valley attracts large numbers of animals year round, offering exceptional game viewing opportunities. Your game drive continues throughout the day as you explore kopjes, riverbanks, and open plains that define the Serengeti ecosystem. Luxury accommodation options include Escarpment Luxury Lodge or Moon-bow Lodge, while mid range travelers return to the comfort of Farm of Dreams Lodge. Optional activities include a sunrise hot air balloon safari, photographic sessions with professional guidance, or an evening sundowner in the wilderness.



<i>Day 5</i>	<i>Lake Manyara National Park and Departure</i> On your final safari day, you drive from the Serengeti or Karatu region to Lake Manyara National Park, a distance of about 70 kilometers depending on your lodge location. The drive takes approximately one hour and leads you to a lush park known for its groundwater forests, tree climbing lions, large herds of elephants, troops of baboons, and thousands of flamingos that feed along the soda lake. A half day game drive offers sightings of hippos, giraffes, zebras, antelopes, and an impressive variety of birds. Lake Manyara is also ideal for nature photographers due to its diverse habitats and dramatic scenery. After your game drive, you begin your journey back to Arusha or Kilimanjaro Airport for your onward flight.
