Day 1. Arusha – Lake Manyara National Park

After breakfast, drive to Lake Manyara Park for game drives with packed lunch. Manyara has a good recorded number of bird species and it's famous for its tree climbing lions. Dinner and overnight at *Lake Manyara lodge/Camp*



Day 2 Manyara – Serengeti National Park

After breakfast, we depart to Serengeti we carve our way through the forested slopes of the Ngorongoro Highlands, en-route with packed lunch, game drives along the way arriving at the lodge/camp just before dusk for dinner & overnight



Day 3

Serengeti National Park
