



DAY 7:

Starting with tasting local ham and Ziskhori (a meat-based dish) in Lentekhi and Ch-olouri, followed by a visit to the 12-14th century Church of St. George in village Sakdri, wrapped up with a polyphonic singing masterclass at dinner and a stay in Lentekhi.

DAY 8:

Out in nature, starting with catching and cooking salmon in the river in the Kheleduri gorge and a masterclass in producing Svan salt in the village Kheledi, finished by a stay in Lentekhi.

DAY 9:

Traveling back from the Lentekhi airport to Natakhtari.



THE PILGRIMAGE TOUR ↘

Svaneti hosts hundreds of Medieval churches, dating back as far as the 8th century and unique to this region. Most churches preserve outstanding murals from as early as the 11-12th centuries. This tour handpicks some of the most unique, breathtaking architecture, keeping our guests busy and inspired.

DAY 1:

A 1-hour flight to Mestia from Natakhtari, a nearby town to the capital of Tbilisi

DAY 2:

Introducing the local culture with the Museum of Ethnography and the Margiani House Museum in Mestia, and some of the most breathtaking Medieval churches: the Church of Transfiguration of Jesus in Laghami, the Lashdghveri Church of St. Michael the Archangel, the Church of St. Gabriel the Archangel in Lashdghveri, followed by a good night's sleep in Mestia.

DAY 3:

Traveling to the charming village of Latali to visit the Church of Ascension of Christ, the Church of Jonah the Prophet in Ienashi, the Church of Christ of Churkhuldi in historic Becho, the Church of Archangels of Pkhuteri in Etseri, the Church of St. George of Svipi in Pari, the Church of Archangel of Kaisha, and the Church of Archangels of Labskaldi in Tskhumari, followed by a stay in Mestia.

DAY 4:

Continuing our search of some of the most unique churches, starting with the Church of Christ in Ieli, the Church of Archangels in Atsi, the Church of Christ of Zhamushi in Mulakhi, the Church of Christ in Chvabiani, the Church of Archangel in Chvabiani, the Church of Archangel of Tvirmi, the Churches of Christ and St. George in Tsvirmi, wrapped up with a stay in Ipari.

DAY 5:

Moving further south to explore some of the most iconic churches, including the Church of St. George in Ipari, the Church of Dormition of the Mother of God in Pekhi, the Churches of St. George and Christ in Adishi, the Church of St. Barbale in Kala, the Church of Kvirike, and the Church of Archangel in Iprali, followed by a stay in Iprali.

DAY 6:

Embracing historic Ushguli, starting with the Museum of Ethnography, the Church of Dormition of the Mother of God in Lamaria, the Church of Christ of Murkmeli, and the Church of Christ of Chazhashi, wrapped up with a stay in Ushguli.

DAY 7:

Traveling further south into Lentekhi to visit the Church of Dormition of the Mother of God of Okondabishi in Chikhareshi (11-14th century), the Church of Archangel in Chukuli (10-12th century), all the way to the Church of St. George in village Sakdri (12-14th century), and the Church of Ascension in Cholouri, followed by a stay in Lentekhi.

DAY 8:

Traveling back from the Lentekhi airport to Natakhtari.



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THE SKI TOUR ↘

With two ski resorts and countless opportunities for ski touring and heliskiing, Svaneti never ceases to amaze our riders. This tour warms our guests up with neat downhill slopes and moves them on to some of the most daring, untouched descents in the backcountry of the Caucasus mountains, filled with breathtaking scenery and rich powder.

DAY 1:

A 1-hour flight to Mestia from Natakhtari, a nearby town to the capital of Tbilisi

DAY 2:

We're taking it slow, introducing our guests to the local culture with a visit to the Museum of Ethnography and skiing on the resorts, wrapping up with a stay in Mestia.

DAY 3:

Exploring our first 2578-meter peak, mount Detsili near the historic village of Becho, followed by a stay in Becho.

DAY 4:

Skitouring up the 2925-meter Guli mountain in Becho, finished with a stay in Mestia.

DAY 5:

Skitouring and diving along the Lamaria mountain range; moving further south to explore historic Ushguli with a stay in the area.

DAY 6:

Diving from the Gorvashi mountain range with a 2899-meter peak.

DAY 7:

Skitouring up to the famous and enchanting Koruldi lakes, attracting eyes and cameras all year round, with a stay in a nearby cabin.

DAY 8:

Skitouring to visit the enchanting Chaaladi glacier of up to 9 square kilometers. Fuelled by peaks like Ushba and Chatini, the glacier conserves three frozen waterfalls, one of which is 300 meters high and 700 meters wide.

DAY 9:

Traveling back from the Mestia airport to Natakhtari.



THE TREKKING TOUR ↘

With rich forests, glistening alpine lakes, towering Caucasus peaks, and thrilling waterfalls, Svaneti never runs out of majestic hiking trails for those with adventurous spirits. Hand-picked daily hikes can span as much as 22 kilometers, so bring your best gear and a watchful gaze to fully take in the magnificence of Svaneti.

DAY 1:

A 1-hour flight to Mestia from Natakhtari, a nearby town to the capital of Tbilisi.

DAY 2:

Taking off from Mestia on a 7-8 hour hike along 10 kilometers to visit the Chalaadi glacier and the Zuruldi mountain, reaching the maximum altitude of 2350 meters. A stay in Mestia.

DAY 3:

Traveling from Mestia to visit the Jvari mountain and the famous, enchanting Koruldi lakes, with an 8-9 hike along 15016 kilometers and the highest altitude of 2600 meters. A good night's sleep in Mestia.

DAY 4:

Traveling to the Mulakhi regions, home to the famous Tetnuldi mountain, and a 2,040-meter village Adishi of 44 inhabitants, with a 6-7 hour walk spanning 15 kilometers, finishing off with a stay in Adishi.

DAY 5:

Visiting the Chkhutnieri mountain pass, the 3-person castle-village Khalde at 1,900 meters above sea level, wrapping up with a walk around historic Iprali at 1,800 meters, home to an 11-century church. A total of 7-8 hours of walking spanning 18 kilometers, with the highest altitude of 2730 meters, concluding with a say in Iprali.

DAY 6:

Visiting the historic village of Davberi, home to a mere 12 inhabitants and enchanting Svan towers. A 5-6 hour walk across 12 kilometers, with a maximum altitude of 2400 meters, finishing with a 1.5-hour car ride and a stay in Mestia.

DAY 7:

Traveling back from the Mestia airport to Natakhtari.
