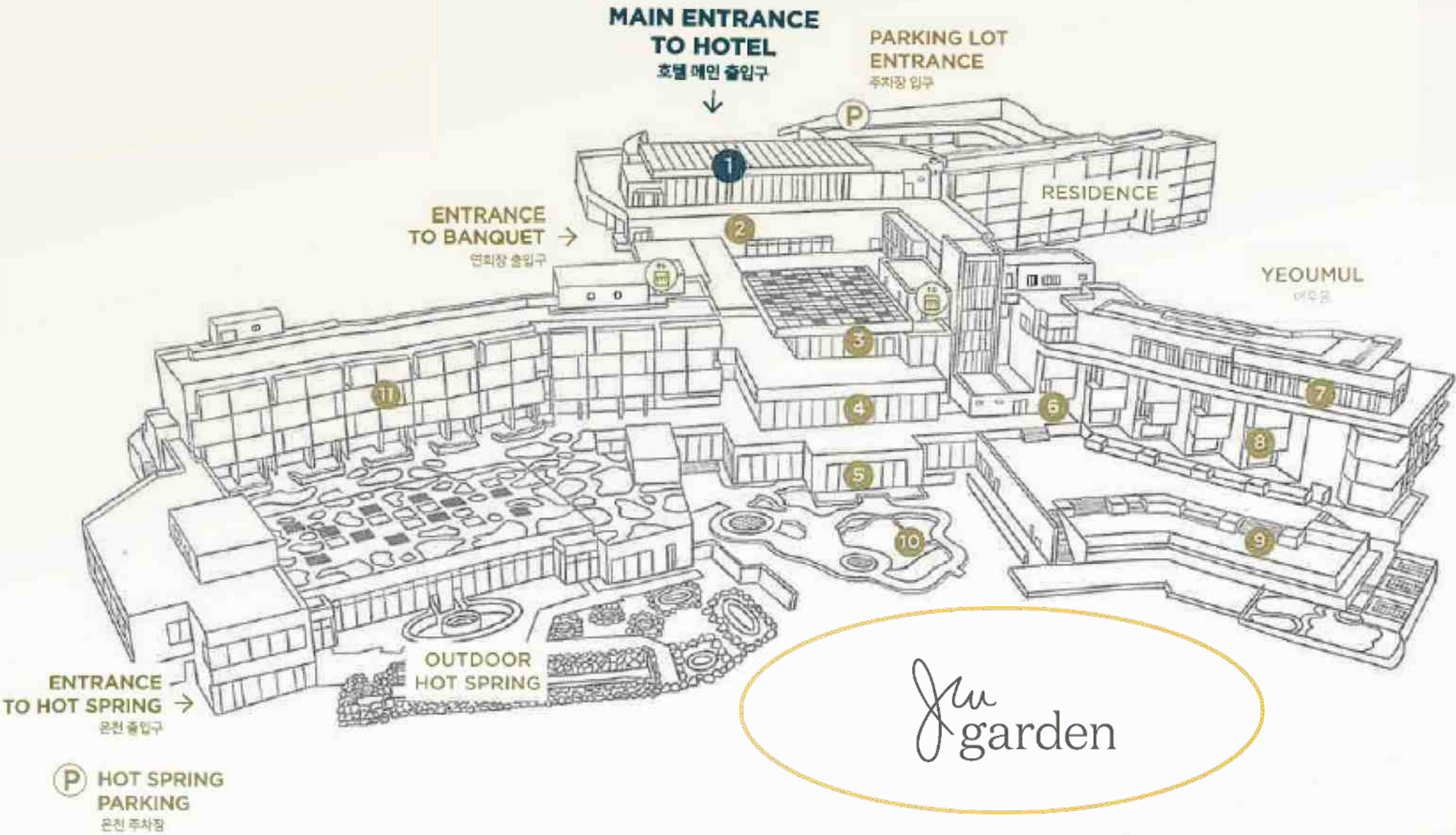

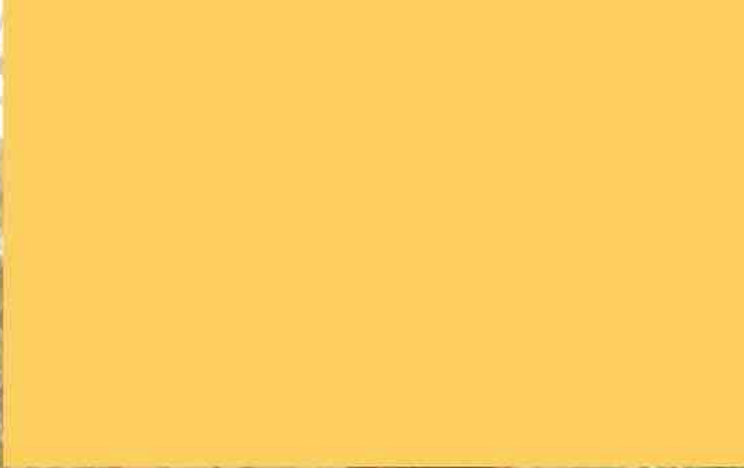

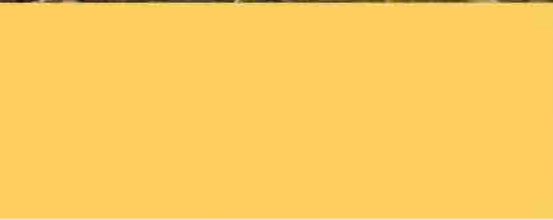
RESORT MAP

- Art Climbing: A guided storytelling walk exploring key art pieces and architectural design elements across the resort.



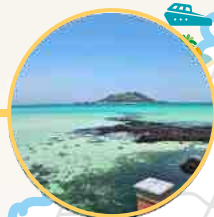
WHERE YOUR WELLNESS JOURNEY CONTINUES

From Airport to Hotel
approx. 50.8 km / 1 hour

Hyeopjae Beach

Approx. 32 km from the hotel

Renowned for its crystal-clear emerald water and long silver-sand shoreline. Calm, shallow waters and vibrant cafés make it ideal for families.



Jungmun Saekdal Beach

Approx. 11 km from the hotel

A four-colored sand beach and one of Korea's premier surf destinations. Consistent waves, striking lava cliffs, and a natural sea cave create a dynamic seaside setting.



Seongsan Ilchulbong

Approx. 44 km from the hotel

A UNESCO World Natural Heritage site famed for its sunrise. A dramatic tuff cone rising from the sea, crowned with a vast crater and 99 jagged peaks—one of Jeju's most iconic landscapes.



Seopjikoji

Approx. 41 km from the hotel

A scenic coastal promontory with sweeping ocean views, lava cliffs, canola fields, and grazing Jeju ponies—all set against the backdrop of Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak.
